Oxford University Press Archives, Oxford, Schulz CP GE 000344, 1 (1 pg.): Sisam to Bell (5.10.1943); the Schulzes are, naturally, good citizens, have very high opinion of them both, Manual of Roman law nowhere near completion, RF, other form of income to be found (Photographed)

Oxford University Press Archives, Oxford, Schulz CP GE 000344, 2 (2 pg.): Bell to Sisam (4.10.1943); finances of Schulz family, salary to Martha Schulz, 'as far as I know the Press is the only source from which Schulz receives anything' (Photographed)
