A letter written by Johannes Michael Scholz, a Mitarbeiter of Helmut Coing, to Prof. Ernst Wahle. It's a reply to a first letter written by Wahle to Coing in 09.01.1969, in which the first one showed his interest in Coing's Ausfuehrungen in München.

It contains an envelope bag, in which there are a letter and several photocopies of the Codex Theresianus.

The letter is typewritten on letterhead of the MPI für Europäische Rechtsgeschichte. The date of the letter is 05.02.1969.

The letter and the photocopies are numbered (149 for the letter, then 150-154). The envelope bag is numbered too (148).

The letter is a reply to another one written by Wahle, in which the latter showed interest in Coing's Ausführungen in München.

The assistant Johannes Michael Scholz underlines Coing's gratitude and answer back to the request submitted by Wahle, sending him the photocopies of the Codex Theresianus.
