NOTES ON THE ARCHIVAL SOURCE:

In a folder containing different kinds of documents and letters, regarding in particular (but not only) Hans Georg Brenner.

A letter written by Pringsheim (at the time in Florence), on the 29<sup>th</sup> of September 1959, to Juliane Partsch, on the occasion of a day in memory of Josef Partsch. Handwritten, one page long. Pringsheim writes to Josef Partsch's widow. He talks about the importance and the works of the latter, also with regards to the studies on Egyptian Law. Pringsheim refers briefly to something Wieacker did with regards to Partsch [Tommaso Beggio: I didn't understand precisely what Pringsheim writes].
