NOTES ON THE ARCHIVAL SOURCE:

A folder containing letters from and to Reinhart Koselleck. One letter written by Wieacker to him (typewritten plus a small handwritten part).

Letter written on the 30th of December, 1975. Two pages long, not numbered. It is all typewritten but the second *post scriptum* (7 lines) and some notes. Wieacker thanks Koselleck for having sent him extracts from the "Historisches Lexicon" and about "Historisch-politische Semantik". He then continues saying that topics like "Freiheit", "Geschichte" and so on [Tommaso Beggio: it is not clear at all, but we can guess they dealt with these topics in some other letters] are very important and "fette" and he himself could talk about them with regards to his subject matters, that are "die Neure [Tommaso Beggio: it is written in this way] Privatrechtsgeschichte und die antike Rechtsgeschichte [Tommaso Beggio: I think it's quite interesting Wieacker uses this terminology, even if he didn't study the "Antike Rechtsgeschichte" in the way it was meant by Wenger and his followers. There are many mistakes in typewriting; it was quite common for Wieacker, but in this letter they make the text more difficult to be read].
