

# TIMELINE

## • Jul 2023

- **OpenAIRE** awarded the contract to develop the **National Open Access Monitor**, as part of the project managed by the **Irish Research eLibrary** (IREL) at Maynooth University.
- Funded by Ireland's **National Open Research Forum** (NORF) through the **Open Research Fund Call**.

## • Sep – Nov 2023

- **First webinar series:** Introduction to the Monitor and training for Research Funding and Performing Organizations (RFOs/RPOs) focusing on **data quality**.

## • Mar 2024

- Official **launch** of the National Open Access Monitor and accompanying **Report**

## • Mar – May 2024

- **Second webinar series:** Advanced training on the Monitor's **functionalities, data quality, and OpenAPC** workflows.

## • Nov 2024

## • Dec 2024 – Apr 2025

- **Third webinar series - Open Insights Sessions:** Interactive sessions to enhance understanding, share best practices, and foster community around Open Access in Ireland.


# DATA BACKBONE: THE OPENAIRE GRAPH

- **A Scientific Knowledge Graph**
  - Timely and comprehensive coverage of research outputs
  - 130K data sources, 3.5M projects, and 290M research outputs (publications, software, datasets, other research products)
  - Near monthly updates
- Precision, depth & processing
  - Rigorous cleaning, deduplication, and enrichment for optimal accuracy
  - Enriched metadata links: Research results to projects, author affiliations, and classifications (FoS, SDG)
  - Techniques for duplicate identification in addition to OpenAIRE's curation tools
- Robustness & openness
  - Maintenance, load balancing, backups, overseen by the OpenAIRE technology centre
  - Open data & transparent methodologies





- **Support Services Overview**
  - Guaranteed support response within 1 business day to initiate resolution procedures.
  - Resolution times for handling infrastructure and software-related issues vary by incident severity type.
  - **Content (Data) Updates**
    - The OpenAIRE Graph content is updated monthly, and the resolution window for content issues ranges from 1 to 2 months.
    - Managers can first review resolutions in the **sandbox** environment for testing and validation before they are implemented in the **production** environment.

- **Who can be a manager and what do managers do?**
  - **RPOs & RFOs can have**
    - 1 **primary** dashboard manager (responsible for deduplication of organisation names on dedicated OpenAIRE Platform: OpenORGS) – must apply by filling out <https://app.onlinesurveys.jisc.ac.uk/s/maynoothuniversity/national-open-access-monitor-dashboard-manager-application-form>
    - **multiple other managers** with access to the **Sandbox** environment for checks of data quality and other improvements (invitation via the platform)



The same organizations usually appear with a variety of names (e.g., full legal name, short or alternative names, acronym), and different metadata information in different data sources. Furthermore, persistent identifiers may be of no help when different data sources identify organizations according to different PID schemas (ROR, ISNI, EC PIC numbers, etc.). This ambiguity results in a considerable efficiency problem in the exchange of information, findability of research products, monitoring of activities, and ultimately building a linked open scholarly communication system.

To address this ambiguity, OpenAIRE developed OpenOrgs, a tool for the disambiguation of organizations involved in the research process which combines an automated process and human curation to compensate for the lack of information available and to improve the organization's discoverability and recognition.

# OPENORGS: How to become a curator

- Be a primary dashboard manager for your RPO: <https://oamonitor.ireland.openaire.eu/how-it-works/user-actions#dashboard-managers>
- Register for an OpenAIRE account: <https://services.openaire.eu/uoa-user-management/register.jsp>
- Request to become a curator: <https://openorgs.openaire.eu/curator>
- OpenOrgs team will process your request.
- You will be able to curate the information for your organization, i.e. identify
  - Duplicates and
  - Parent/Child relationships (e.g. University & Department)

# OPENORGS

- What should I do if my RPO is not displayed on the National Open Access Monitor, Ireland?
  - This means that your RPO has not been incorporated in OpenAIRE and OpenOrgs. The process is to:
    - Contact us: <https://oamonitor.ireland.openaire.eu/contact-us>
    - Request a ROR id, if you do not already have one. [ROR Request Form](#)
    - Inform us when you have a ROR id assigned to your RPO.
  - We will process all RPOs that do not have a ROR id and inform them about the process.
