



Why was Base4NFDI created?

Since March 2023, NFDI (funded by the DFG) comprises 26 discipline-specific consortia that offer tools, services and advice for working with FAIR data. Base4NFDI, the joint initiative of all consortia, decided to promote cross-disciplinary basic services by offering financial and personnel support for their stepwise development.

What is our mission?

- Establish NFDI-wide services for FAIR research data management
- Ensure interoperability with (inter-)national infrastructures and policies

What will Base4NFDI provide?

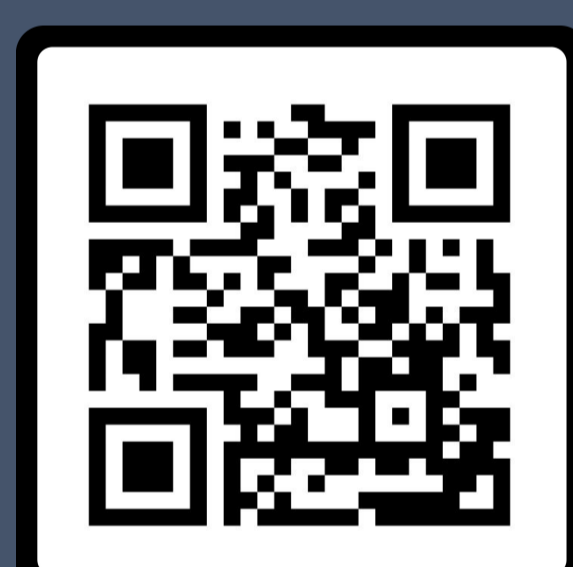
A framework for:
