 - How often did you use LLMs in the past and for which tasks?
 - Which LLMs did you use in the past?
 - How knowledgeable are you of the way LLMs work and how users may interact with them?
- Use of LLMs.
 - Which LLM did you use in the past weeks? What is the rationale of the choice?
 - How often did you use it and for which tasks? Did you find it useful? In which way?
 - How long did it take you to interact with the instrument? What are the major challenges you faced while interacting with it?
 - Did you make use of any pattern to improve the interaction with the tool?
