Data management plan required?	Yes - to maintain research integrity, institutions and researchers must ensure research data is preserved so that results can be verified and the data reused in future. The Academy expects all of its award holders to maximise the availability of research data. Therefore, in your application form you may be requested to provide a Data Management and Sharing plan.' In addition, they state that if the research data is of significant value to the research community then a data management and sharing plan should be submitted.
