

Getting Started

To begin, please carefully read the instructions on how to use Copilot. Then, figure out how to start the application. Complete the practice tasks in any order you see fit, and make sure all the verification steps are successful.

How to use Copilot

- Many features of Copilot have been disabled. We ask you to only use Copilot through the chat window, which can be accessed through the icon with downwards arrow at the top of the screen, to the right of the workspace name.
- We ask you to **not** use the **Edits** or **Inline Chat** functionality.
- Please do **not delete** chats you are done with. If you want to start a new chat, click the "+" icon on the top right.

Important: Copilot will, by default, only see the file you have currently opened. To have Copilot search all the files, include the **#codebase** command in your question, or start your question with **@workspace**. For more useful commands and tips for using Copilot, send **/help** in the Copilot chat.

Feel free to experiment with Copilot during the practice tasks.

Practice Task A - Change color

When there are no TODOs, there is a red box with the message "No TODOs here yet". Change the color of this box to blue (#007bff).

Verification:

- Refresh the application. Confirm that the message "No TODOs here yet" shows up in a blue box.

Practice Task B - Change Placeholder

The placeholder text of the input field is currently "What needs to be done?". Change the text to "Enter a task here".

Verification:

- Refresh the application. Confirm the placeholder is now "Enter a task here".

Practice Task C - Sort TODOs

The TODOs are currently displayed in the order they were added. Modify the application so that the TODOs are sorted alphabetically instead.

Verification:

- Add the following TODOs, in this order: "the", "quick", "123", "brown", "fox". Confirm that the TODOs are displayed in this order (alphabetically): "123", "brown", "fox", "quick", "the".
