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Dr. Smith rejoices in the common conscience of the Allies, particularly of England, France, and the United States. He thinks that these countries have been welded together in such fashion that they will guarantee the peace of the world whatever comes. It is good to read these strong words in the days of uncertainty that still hang over us. It is a great inheritance that has come o America to be in so goodly a fellowship.
