The problem

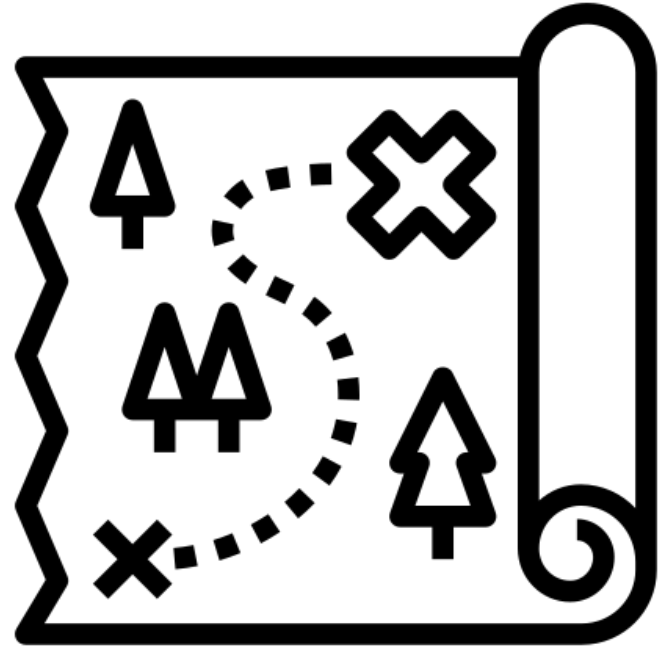
We do not have reliable institutional affiliation information for each of the 25,000 data publications at Dryad
