Description/ observations:	Donated by Tuerlinckx. Maker active from 1782–1840. Bell inner bore is almost straight, in same style as Tuerlinckx's full-sized bassoons and FT 34. Bell diameter is smaller at the top (north). There are also similarities in the platform. Keys are mounted on metal. Platform on long joint. Butt joint has a hook to hold it. VO: Butt joint has been made from wood cut in the opposite way than normal.
