DATES OF PUBLICATION OF THE NOVARA REISE

Collections made during the voyage of the frigate Novara produced zoological and botanical material which was described by various specialists in the series of monographs published by the Academy of Science of Vienna. These publications are scientific contributions with descriptions and names of many new species, and accurate fixation of dates of publication of the various parts is important in zoological nomenclature. The dates printed upon the titlepages are not always accurate, and examination shows that there was delay in some cases in the appearance of the finished part (Heft). The separate Hefte were actually published with front and back covers of thick yellowish paper, and each one includes a special Heft title-page, and various title-pages for the general work and for the section, in addition to text and plates. In the case of the larger monographs (e.g., Lepidoptera) special instructions were issued for binding. These instructions are nearly always followed, when the dated front covers, printed with title and details of the contents of the part, and many of the unwanted title-pages are discarded and text and plates each assembled in separate volumes, so that the order of publication may be concealed, and the result is confusing. Today the Hefte in original state are difficult to find, but it happens that I possess a copy of the Lepidoptera section, of which the parts are bound separately with the front covers to each Heft preserved, and in the case of the first three Hefte at least, there is every indication that the page sequence is undisturbed. Another copy bound up in this way exists in the library of the British Museum (Bloomsbury), and the volumes containing the first three Hefte of Lepidoptera compared with mine contain almost the same title-pages, text, and plates. In the cases of Hefte 4 and 5 there are small differences which will be referred to later.

Another source of information is to be found in the Sitzungsberichte (Proceedings) of the Royal Academy. Here are recorded the dates upon which a copy of the part in question was tabled for examination by members of the Council of the Academy. Three of the Hefte dealing with Lepidoptera were announced in this way. The fact that publication was in parts (Hefte) needs emphasis. In the volumes which deal with Lepidoptera, with which I am most familiar, each plate bears two dates the precise meaning of which is obscure. For example, Plate XIV shows a small engraved inscription at the bottom left-hand corner: del.Mart.1864 edit.Oct.1864. Similar dates appear on all plates in both plain and coloured copies of the work. The abbreviation "edit." was taken to mean "published" in the sense of distribution or put on sale, by Dos Passos in his note about this book, but I submit that this conclusion is not justified by the facts. To "edit" does not mean strictly "to put on sale", and since the inscription is an integral part of the engraving on the plate, it can scarcely relate to the actual date of sale or distribution. Perhaps it may indicate the date upon which the finished engraving was returned by the artist (Carl Geyer). It will be obvious from the collation that follows, that on the title-page of each Heft it is recorded which plates are included, and clearly both text and plates were distributed together

in this way. Again, the Instructions to Bookbinders (Anweisung etc., item 1) refer to the Lepidoptera section as appearing in five Hefte, and the secretary always reported the appearance of complete Hefte to the Council. As far as I know incomplete Hefte do not occur as they might if plates and text were distributed independently, and I think that all evidence goes to show that the various Hefte were distributed complete. The plates in this work may be plain or coloured. In a letter to Hewitson² Dr. Felder explained that all parts were produced with plain plates and coloured copies were made later for specific orders only. This involved some delay and Hewitson records³ that he received his (coloured) copy of Heft 2 early in 1867, although the part was published first late in 1865. Felder also stated in this letter that the edition comprised 400 copies.

In the following notes I give: (1) A collation of the copy of the Lepidoptera section in my possession, which belonged originally to Roland Trimen; (2) The dates of the appearance of all parts of the work so far as I can trace them in the official records of the Sitzungsberichte.

Note. In the B.M. copy of Heft 2 the plates are complete but the text runs only to page 352. The missing pages are included with Heft 3 in which the text runs from p.353 to p.535. The back cover of thick paper is missing from the B.M. copy of volume 2.

The nomenclature of the first thirty-three plates of Heterocera (i.e., plates 75–107) was already settled when this happened, and Rudolf Felder was responsible for the names on these plates, but not for their publication. Alois Rogenhofer was responsible for the nomenclature on plates 108–140 and for the publication of all plates of Heterocera, so that the Felder names on these plates are really all "in litt."

(w) Berichtigung (to Heft 1-3). 1 page.

The copy in the British Museum (Bloomsbury) varies in a few details from that in my possession. It is more complete, inasmuch as, with two exceptions, both front and back covers are retained to all five Hefte. The variations in Hefte 1, 2, and 3 in this copy have been already recorded. The items in Hefte 4 and 5 appear as follows:

The Vorwort and Volume title-page (r) are both dated 1875 and appear out of place in this Heft which is dated 1874. The thick back cover is wanting.

In both copies there is little evidence that the text sequence has been altered, and it seems probable that the text sections were sometimes assembled at different times and in a different order. In the case of the B.M. copy the corrected date "1865" on the front cover to Heft 1 may suggest a late copy, as does the omission of the superfluous title-page (b), the issue of which was clearly premature.

(2). Data from the Sitzungsberichte der Kaiserliche Akademie der Wissenschaften in Wien (mathemat. naturw. Classe. 1 Abtheilung).

This publication contains the record of Proceedings at the Council meetings, often held weekly. The reports and monographs concerned with the Novara Reise were published by the Akademie, and the various Hefte as they appeared were often presented to the Council at their meetings. When this was done, and the dates when the Hefte were tabled are compared with the dates of publication printed on the title-pages of the Hefte, it is clear that there was often delay in production and the printed dates are sometimes inaccurate. Since the Sitzungsberichte are not easily available, I have recorded below all dates that I can trace after examination of these proceedings.

Zoologischer Theil, Band 2, Abtheil. 2; Lepidoptera. Not 1865 12 Jan. recorded at the previous meeting on 5 January, the announcement is:- "Der Sekretär legt vor die eben erschienenen Zweite Abtheilung des Zoologischen Theiles des Novara Reisewerkes, enthaltend die Lepidoptera, bearbeitet von Herrn Dr. Cajetan Felder und Rudolf Felder." It appears that this Heft, dated 1864 upon the title-page, did not become available until January 1865. In the list of new books added to the library which appears on the following page of the Berichte (p. 82) the part is recorded as 1865, and this date appears upon the thick front cover of the copy preserved in the British Museum (Bloomsbury). 27 April Geologischer Theil, Band 1, Abtheilung 2.

1875 7 Jan. "Der Sekretar legt das eben beendigte vierte Heft der von weil. Rudolf Felder & A. F. Rogenhofer vor".

14 Oct. Anthropologischer Theil. 1 Abtheilung by Zukerkandal.

We may suppose that the Hefte were presented to the Council as soon as possible after publication, and it is evident that the dates printed upon the title-pages are sometimes inaccurate and delays in production occurred. In Heft 3 of the Lepidoptera section the title-page is dated 1866-Mars 1867, but the front cover of the part is dated 1867 only. In fact the part was tabled on 25 April 1867, and this should be taken as the date of publication. In the case of Heft 4, dated November 1874, publication was certainly delayed. This part was not announced to the Council at any meeting in November or December of that year, but it was tabled on 7 January 1875 which should be accepted as the actual date of publication. Other inaccuracies appear, for example in 1869, when the Ethnographie Heft by Muller was not presented until 1 April although dated 1868. These examples are sufficient to cast doubt upon the dates that appear on the title-pages of the various Hefte, and the dates recorded in the Sitzungsberichte are more acceptable; it is unfortunate that these records are not quite complete.

The data presented suggest that the following dates may be accepted for the

Lepidoptera section of the Novara Reise.

Heft 1. 12 January 1865. Names by C. & R. Felder.

Heft 2. After October 1865 but before the end of that year? No record in the Sitzungsberichte. Names by C. & R. Felder.

Heft 3. 25 April 1867. Names by C. & R. Felder.

Heft 4. 7 January 1875. Published by A. Rogenhofer, but names on Plates 75-107 by Rudolf Felder in litt.

Heft 5. On or after July 1875. No record in the Sitzungsberichte. All names by A. Rogenhofer.
