THE TYPE SPECIES OF THE ANT GENUS EURHO-PALOTHRIX.— In our paper, "A world revision of the ant tribe Basicerotini," Studia Entomologica, Petrópolis, Brazil, 3: 202, 1960, we erected a new genus Eurhopalothrix to receive certain species formerly placed in Rhopalothrix Mayr, along with some new species. Through inadvertance, no type species was cited for the new genus, and we therefore here designate Eurhopalothrix bolaui (=Rhopalothrix bolaui Mayr, 1870) as type species of the genus Eurhopalothrix Brown and Kempf.—W.
