When I think about my lost cattle, it makes me sad. In 2016 I lost 15 cows. I tried so hard to save them, even taking them to places where I thought were better but they died anyway. I was left with 6 cows only. A bag of 50 kg flour in my house only lasts for a week then I am required to buy another one again. I always need to have money to buy flour and for this I have to sell goats. I sold about 5 goats recently to make ends meet. I lost 11 goats in 2016 mostly because of livestock diseases and drought. I did not receive any help in terms of medicine etc and no advice.

I lost all my household goods due to this year's flood such as spades and hoes, including my garden. All gone. Even the rest of the communities are going through the same things.

1. Explain how the drought has affected you and your family for the past 20 years in terms of livestock loss, family income and other areas impacted by drought or flood

I had 80 cattle, and now I am only left with 20. With sheep, 25 of them died and now I only have 4. All these because of drought. I have no livestock, I lost almost everything. It affected me badly. I used to own 400 goats and now I am only left with 5 goats. We used to live in abundance when rain was in our favor, we got enough milk from the cattle and we had more than enough food. There are others who are worse than me, though I had 400 goats, there are those who don't have anything at all and those who lost absolutely everything.

I used to have so many goats, countless and sheep and have lost 300 sheep and have lost more than 500 goats, now I only have 80 goats left and 15 sheep left. All the goats I have now, are new goats that I bought to start over. I keep adding here and there as years goes by. I had to buy new goats because I lost everything. Recently some people also stole my cow. They are only 9 now.

During drought, there is hardly any food for the goats except near the river where there are crocodiles and that is how they are taken by the crocodiles. We lost 3 cows recently and about 30 within ten years. In 2015 alone we lost 7 cows. These 7 cows were the only ones left after my husband died and we lost them as well. The 3 that we got last year, we also already lost and now we have no cows at all.
