If we are provided with these, it will help us. We also need water tank with enough pressure like the ones in Etunda irrigation project. They should be erected on a good height to have enough pressure. If we are using energy from the sun, we won't run out. The intervention by the government is helpful but not sufficient. For example, they give orphans and vulnerable children N\$250 per child and this is not enough. It does not help much because imagine what you can buy with N\$250, when children need food and cloths such as school uniforms. If they make it N\$1000, it is better and will feed the families. We do not have power and no assistance with even loans to help us with farming activities. Interventions such as small business loans to even start a take away, will be helpful to make a living and because you sign a contract, you need to find a way to be paying it back. These things are not implemented in this community.
