Description/ observations:	Key flap surfaces are shell-engraved. Ferrules have intricate patterns of ornamentation. Maker's stamp mistakenly has some doubled letters. Tone hole C position has been changed. Double cork. Small tone holes on wing joint with almost no angle. Boot joint tone holes very large, but with usual angles.
