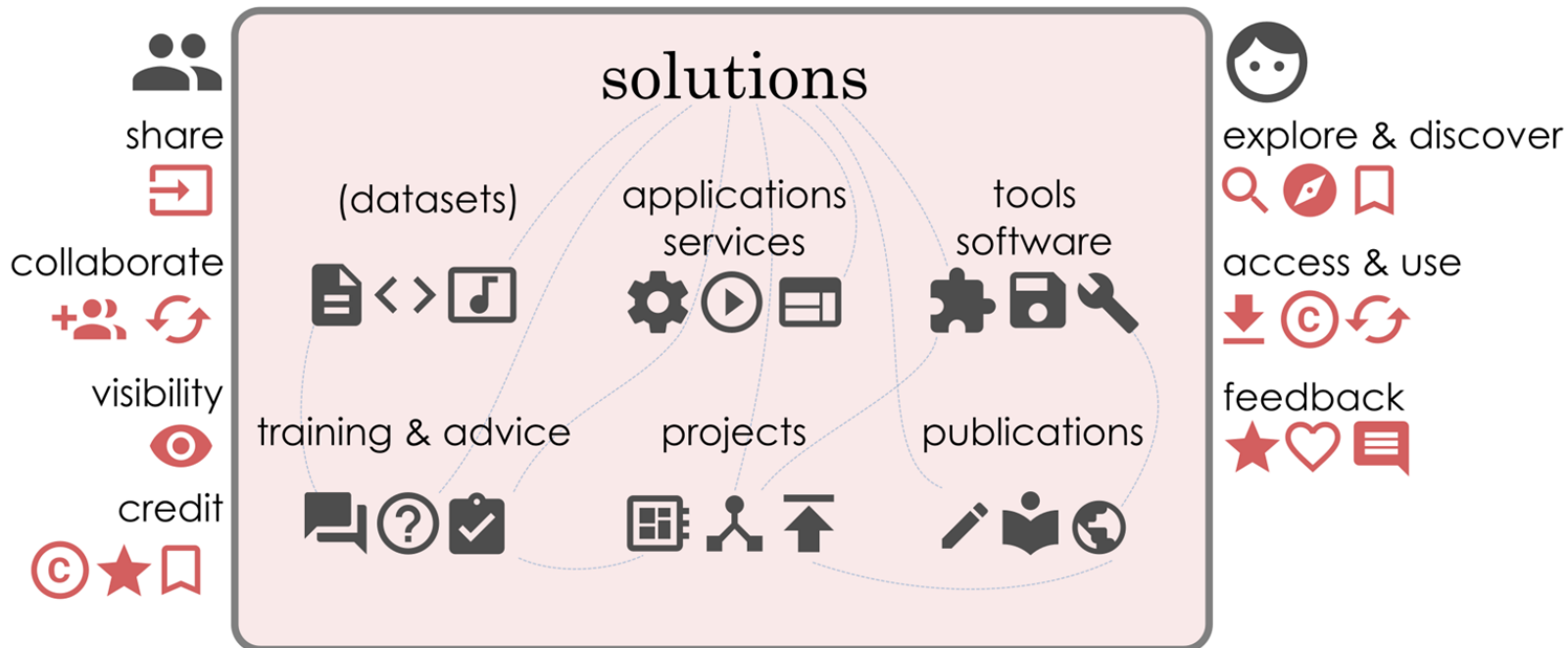

# SSH Open Marketplace

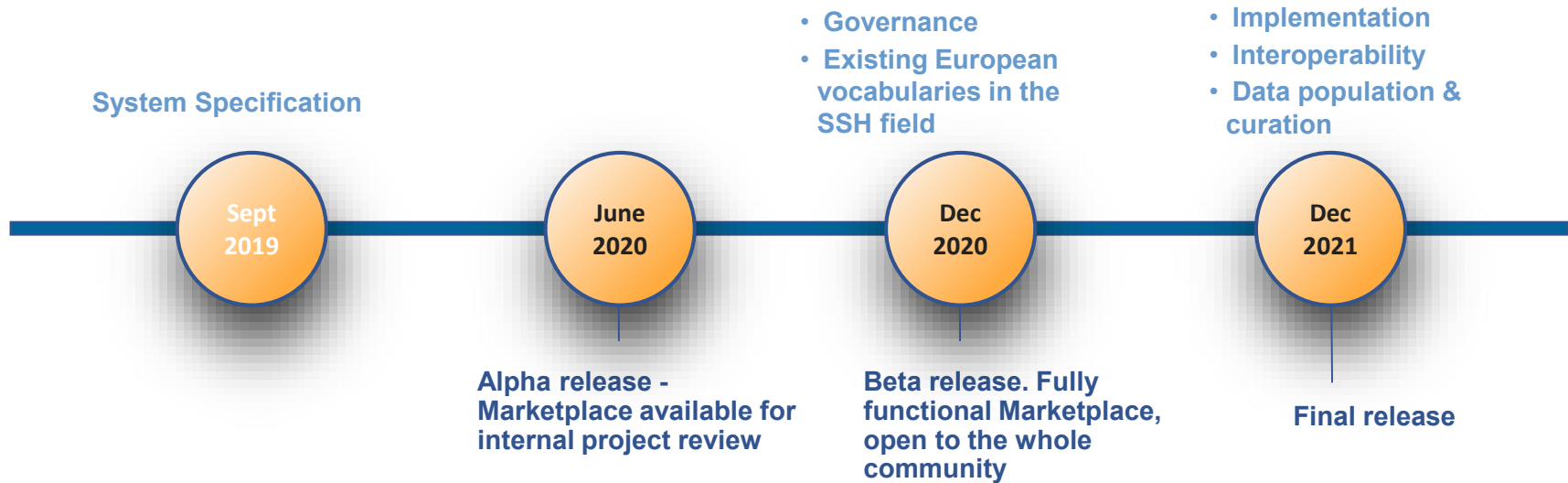
DARIAH developing Marketplace (WP7) in SSHOC project

- Community - crowdsourcing, feedback
- Curation - governance, moderation
