Description/ observations:	French-system style. Different from the other Scherer models: only one cork opening in the butt joint, instead of two. <i>Ab</i> key is rectangular. Ferrules have different engravings. Bell has no crown, no inner bell chamber and a different design from other Scherer models. Four bocals are not original, three short and one in L-shape. On long joint, D, C, and <i>Bb</i> tone holes are undercut, with no platform.
