

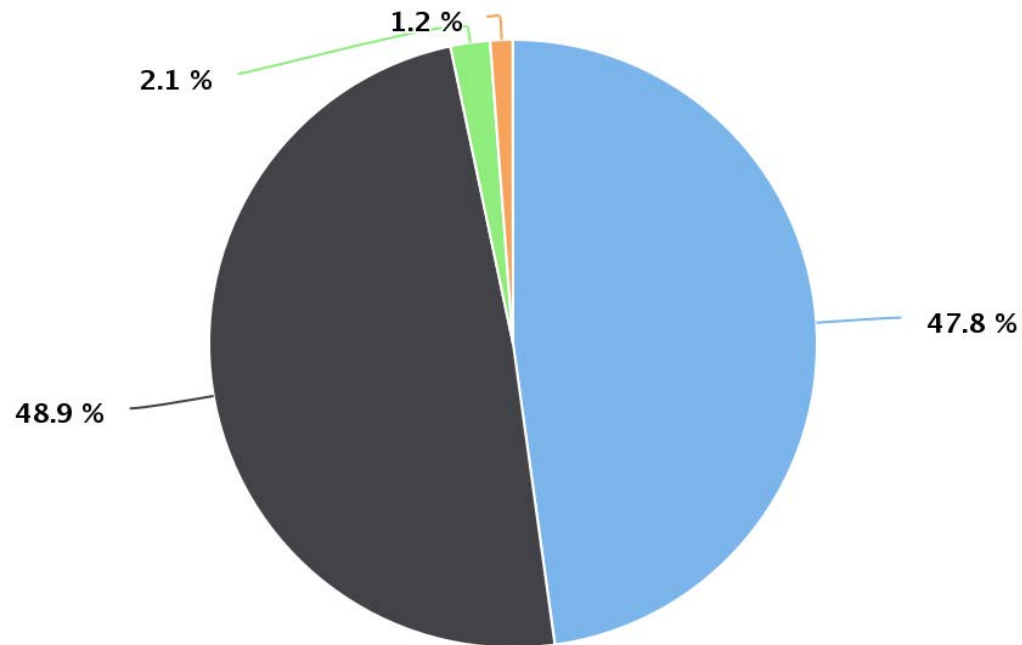

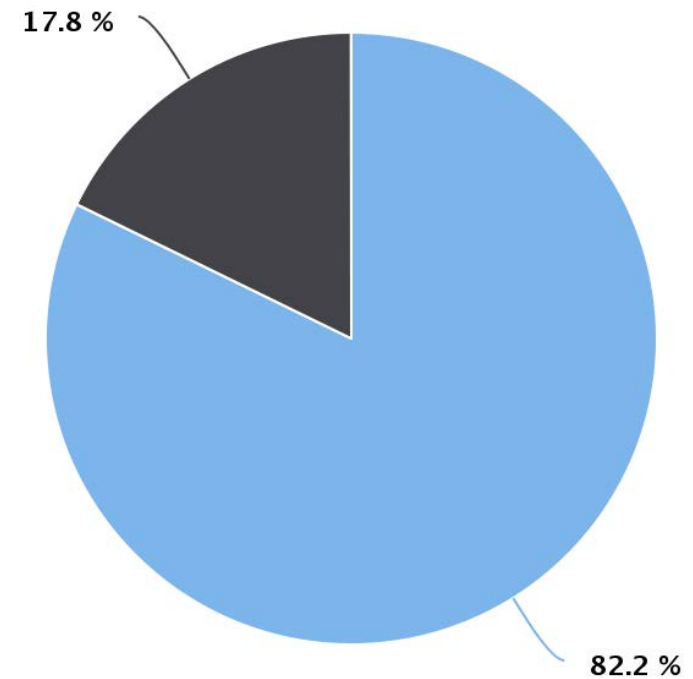

## DFHG Fragmentary Authors Catalog

The *DFHG Fragmentary Authors Catalog* is a tool developed by the *DFHG Project* for searching and visualizing the **636 Greek fragmentary historians** collected in the *Fragmenta Historicorum Graecorum (FHG)* by Karl Müller. This tool is complementary to the other tools of the DFHG Project. The resource can be consulted in conjunction with the *index auctorum* and the *index titulorum* of the *FHG*.

### Search Fields

The *DFHG Fragmentary Authors Catalog* enables users to search the catalog by:

- **Authors** collected in the *FHG*: e.g., *Hippys Rheginus*.
- **Volumes** of the *FHG*: e.g., *FHG 2*.

### Output

The results display the following data (when available):

- **FHG Volume**: e.g., *FHG 1*.
- **FHG Sub\_Volume**: e.g., *Liber primus*.
- **Historical period** of a group of *FHG* authors according to the classification of Müller: e.g., *Inde ab incunabulis artis historicae usque ad finem Belli Peloponnesiaci*.
- **Date** of the historical period of a group of *FHG* authors according to the classification of Müller: e.g., *520-404 B.C.*
- **FHG Author**: e.g., *Critias Atheniensis*.
- **FHG pages** with links to the printed edition of the *FHG* available through *Archive.org*.
- **CITE urn** of each *FHG* author: e.g., *urn:cite:lofts:fhg.1.hellanicus*.
- **Places** corresponding to the geographical epithet of each *FHG* author according to Müller and with links to the *Pleiades gazetteer*.



Fragmentary Authors Map

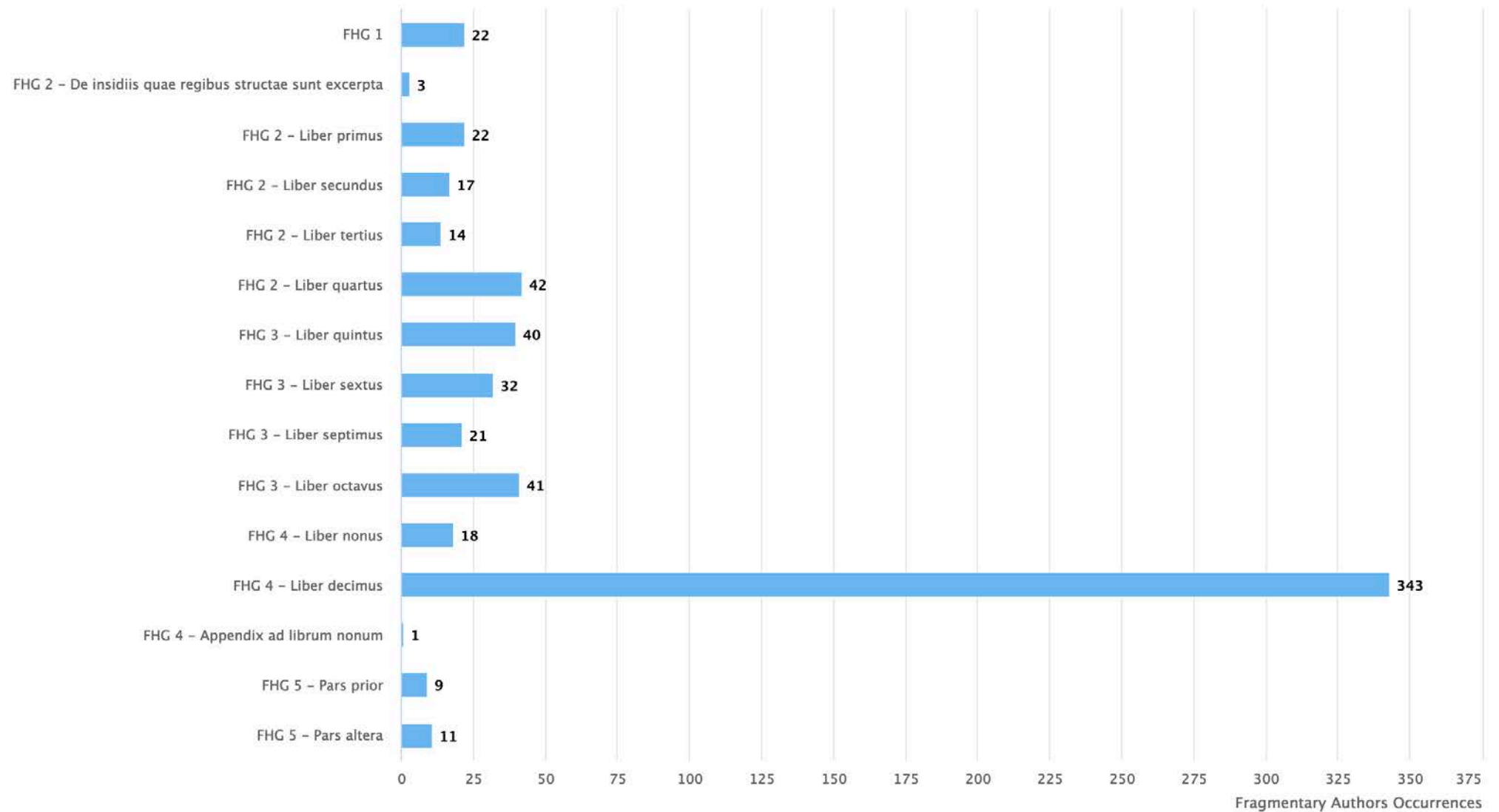


Fragmentary Authors Chart

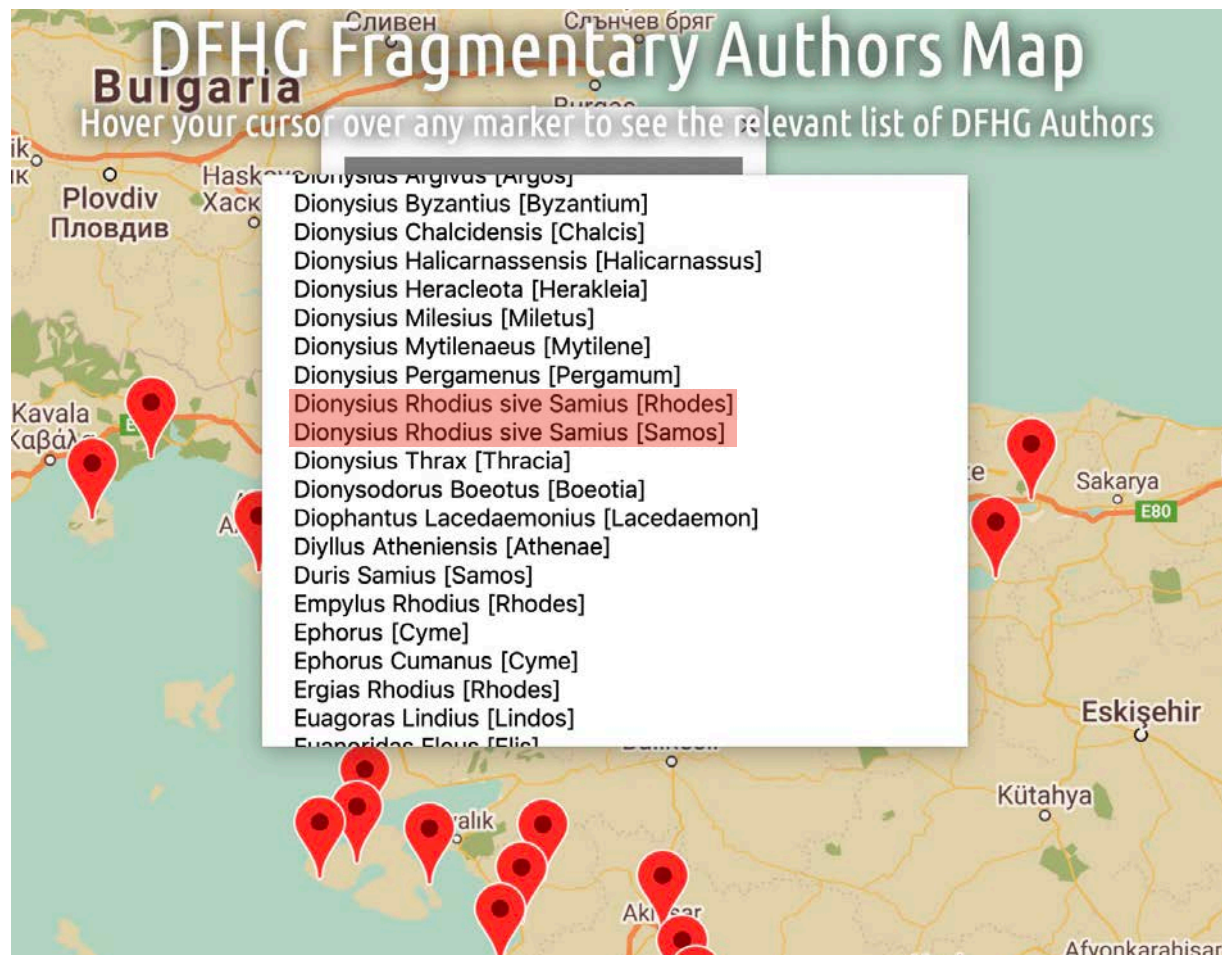

### DFHG Witnesses Catalog - Text Reuse Detection

The *DFHG Witnesses Catalog - Text Reuse Detection* is a tool developed by the [DFHG Project](#) for automatic text reuse detection of Greek fragmentary historians collected in the *Fragmenta Historicorum Graecorum (FHG)* by Karl Müller. This tool is complementary to the other tools of the DFHG Project.

The tool allows users to automatically detect text reuses in source texts by inserting an XML file URL or selecting one of the PerseusDL/OGL editions (leave the XML file URL field empty and press Submit to obtain the PerseusDL/ OGL editions list). Detected source text XML files can be downloaded and include a DFHG attribute marking up the reuse.

PerseusDL is the *Perseus Digital Library* collection of Greek and Latin texts ([GitHub](#)). OGL is the *Open Greek and Latin* collection, which includes also the *First One-Thousand Years of Greek* texts ([GitHub](#)).

The "text reuse detection" functionality is based on the Smith–Waterman algorithm that performs local sequence alignment to detect similarities between strings. Smith–Waterman has been used for sequencing DNA, and for detecting plagiarism and collusion by comparing sequences of text.

### Search Fields

The *Text Reuse Detection* enables users to select the following entries of the *DFHG Witnesses Catalog*:

- **Authors** collected in the *FHG*: e.g., [Phanodemus](#) or [Hellanicus](#).
- **Works** of authors collected in the *FHG*: e.g., [ATTIKA](#).
- **Witnesses (authors)** who preserve text reuses of *FHG* authors and works: e.g., [Harpocraton](#).
- **Witnesses (works)** that preserve text reuses of *FHG* authors and works: e.g., [Deipnosophistae](#).
