

Euphresco in a few words

Euphresco was initiated as a network of research programme owners and programme managers funded under the 6th and 7th EU framework programme from 2006 to 2014.

The network started with 23 organisations from 17 countries and is now composed of 70 ca. members from more than 50 countries in 5 continents.

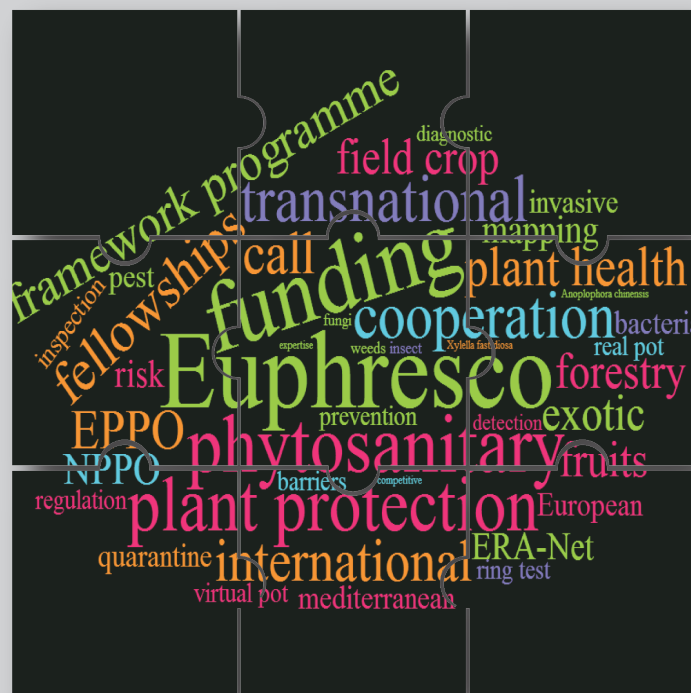
Euphresco became a sustainable network in April 2014 and the network secretariat is hosted by the European and Mediterranean Plant Protection Organization.

Research funding under Euphresco

Euphresco's main objective is to coordinate national programmes on phytosanitary research. The liaison with other national, European and international initiatives ensures a coherent strategy for setting priorities and avoiding overlaps among projects funded under different mechanisms. So far eight calls have been organised and 100 ca. research projects have been funded.

Euphresco funded projects: examples

Strategies for *Ambrosia artemisiifolia* control (2008-2009).

Evaluating the risk of spread of *Scaphoideus titanus* with propagation material (2008-2009).

Development of validated procedures for whole genome amplification of DNA/RNA for quarantine plant pathogens and pests (2009-2010).

Ring test of diagnostic methods for *Pantoea stewartii* subsp. *stewartii* (2008-2009).

Development and validation of innovative diagnostic tools for detection and identification of *M. enterolobii* in support of integrated plant protection strategies (2012-2013).

Bursaphelenchus xylophilus: methods for early detection (2013-2014).

IPM strategies against *Drosophilidae* (2014-2016).

Harmonized protocol for monitoring and detection of *Xylella fastidiosa* in its host plants and its vectors (2016-2018).

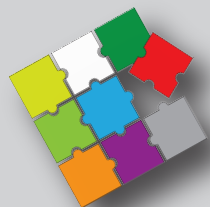
The application of Next-Generation Sequencing technology for the detection and diagnosis of non-culturable organisms: viruses and viroids (2016-2018).
