# **1. SDGs in the Arctic context**

- SDGs: intertwine between social-economicenvironmental priorities
- Role of climate services and infrastructure development goals
- Synergy of impacts:
  - change in the Arctic systems: *natural* + *societal*
  - regional + global drivers of change
- Gradual merge between Arctic and global sustainability agenda
- Challenges: risks & opportunities for SDGs

- State level is crucial for SD target setting
- Arctic states adopted national Arctic strategies
- Innovation in approaches: Polycentric adaptive governance might be a wise option to deal with Synergy of Arctic change
- Links between levels

#### SD in AC: Significant contribution during 20 years

- Sustainability agenda from the early start: 1998 SDWG
- "2030 Agenda and the Arctic", UN SD Forum, July 2018
- SD theme cross-cutting
- Results and failures
- Assessment/Diagnosis
- Russia in AC

### 4. Other intergovernmental bodies

#### SDGs 14-15: Biodiversity conservation

- Protected areas: terrestrial 20%, 4.7% marine (CBD target up to 10%)
- Global regimes 0.9% of the region: 80-RAMSAR; 12- WH sites
- Voluntary mechanisms: CSR + sustainability
- UNCLOS challenge: BD beyond national jurisdiction
- Local challenges: risks and opportunities
  - Subsistence economy
  - Tourism
  - Access
