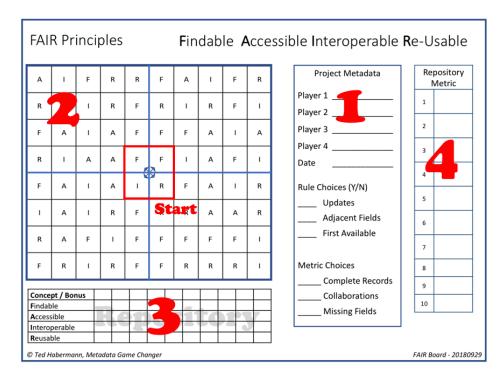
## The Metadata Game

## **Project Tools**

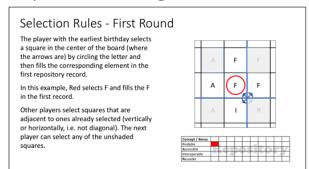
Tools are available for

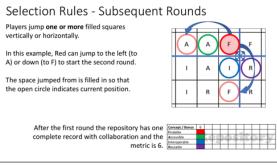
- 1. tracking project metadata,
- 2. selecting metadata elements,
- 3. recording repository content,
- 4. recording repository metrics after each round.

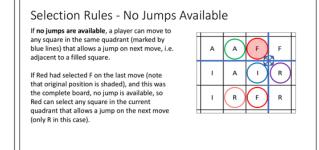
Start on one of the squares with the arrows.



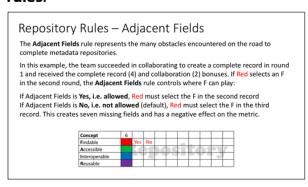
Metadata elements are selected when players land on squares on the board. Players movements are controlled by a few simple rules. Planning these moves collaboratively is critical to team success.



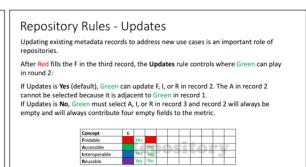




There are also rules for building the repository. **These rules need to be considered in team plans along with the selection rules**.







Metrics are quantitative tools for measuring progress on the project and the goal is to maximize the metric for ten metadata records. Teams can define their metrics depending on the relative importance of completeness, collaboration, and empty fields. There are some default values.
