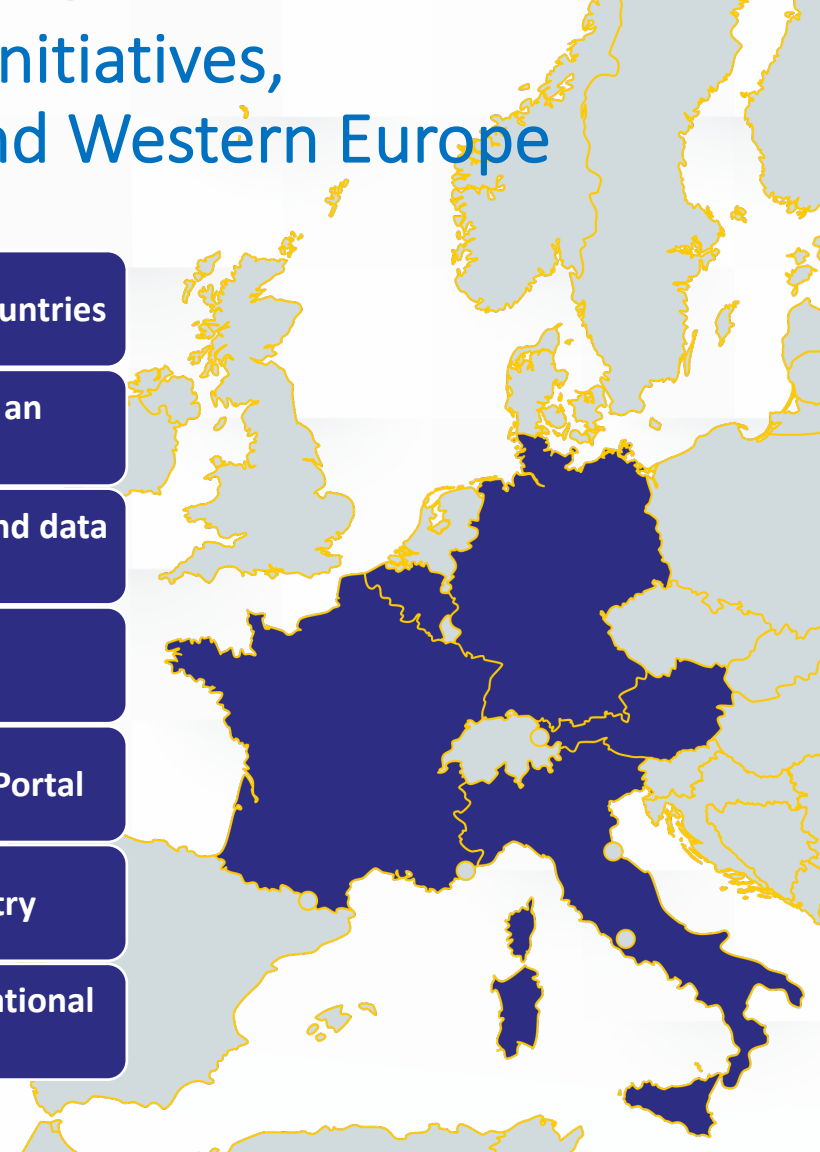

- I** Harmonised procedures for research data services delivery across countries
- M** Coordination with other initiatives to achieve harmonisation for an inclusive EOSC

Understanding the market: a common need for EOSC projects

- ★ All INFRAEOSC-5b related projects have ‘landscaping’ activities in their DoA
 - ★ Obvious area of inter-project collaboration
 - ★ Inter-project coordination discussed before the start of the projects
 - ★ Collaboration board being setup with help from EOSC Secretariat
 - ★ EOSC-Pillar survey implementation (WP3 lead by Lisa Hönegger , University of Wien)

Topics of EOSC-Pillar survey

- ★ Business models, SLAs and user support
- ★ Access policies, authorization and authentication models, privacy and legal aspects
- ★ Data management and certification
- ★ Communities, Services and Usage



Target groups



- ★ Methodology : establishing a list of identified recipients within 4 distinct groups
 - ★ e-Infrastructures (including data repositories, data archives, digital archives of national museums, data/computing centres, grid infrastructure, HPC's, NREN's)
 - ★ Research Infrastructures (of national relevance)
 - ★ Funding bodies
 - ★ Universities

EOSC-Pillar Survey in practice

- ★ Designed by a multi disciplinary team led by experts in social sciences
- ★ Different target groups will receive different sets of question
- ★ Depending on the target group, roughly between 15 and 80 questions per group; structured in 5 blocs (core module and 4 thematic modules) – expected time to answer is below 30 minutes.
- ★ Implemented using LimeSurvey
- ★ Consent form to be signed by respondent (covering internal usage and cross project usage)

EOSC-Pillar Survey in practice

- ★ Results will be pseudonymized (name/key files handled and in possession by EOSC-Pillar (UNIVIE)).
- ★ Respondents can be contacted for follow-up questions
- ★ Use of the collected targets planned for a second round of questions
- ★ Survey and methodology are property of EOSC Pillar but can be used, once finished, under CC license by other projects
- ★ Should provide information to the Executive Board Landscape WG
