

Efficiently starting institutional research data management

Strategy Development

RISE-DE is a reference model for self-evaluation and target setting in institutional research data management. It is suitable as a tool for designing stakeholder-oriented strategy processes. RISE-DE was developed on the basis of DCC's RISE framework and adapted for use in the German scientific context.



Legal Issues

With this guideline central units of the university such as libraries, computer centres or research departments learn which legal experts at their own institution could be cooperated with, in which cases external actors should be involved and to what extent the establishment or expansion of their own legal competence appears necessary for the RDM portfolio.



Start

The train-the-trainer programme is an interactive multiplier programme which imparts basic knowledge in the most important aspects of RDM. Methods can be directly transferred by the participants to their own trainings. The contents have been published in form of extensive materials such as teaching scripts, working materials and an explanatory concept.



Competence Enhancement

The research data policy kit is designed as a modular system that takes both general and individual conditions into account. With the help of guiding questions and text modules, each university can compile its own research data policy. The policy kit is supplemented by a guideline that supports universities in their strategic approach to implement a research data policy.
