Description/ observations:	Whisper key was damaged, bent and missing pad support and link to key mechanism; apparently repaired in the past, it has now again been repaired. Big double crack historically repaired inside butt joint; wood wall between big and small bore at top would have otherwise come out. Prominent crack with a biconvex shape, very elongated, following wood veins, on the right side of the C hole on long joint. Two cracks going up from bell bottom ferrule, historically sealed. Under the touch of keys, residues of red sealing wax are visible; probably used as an adhesive to hold corks under key touch.
