

- 2. Peer reviewed, crowdsourced, singular
- 3. Personal, adaptive
- 4. Meritocratic
- 5. Biomimetic, open pedagogy
- 6. Free of curriculae and agenda
- 7. Non-authorative evaluation (consensus)
- 8. Universal

## FREE EDUCATION – "IDEAL" IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. Governance open and transparent
- 2. Infrastructure open and common
- 3. Schools built as platforms
- 4. Services and goods leave space for profit and competition.
