A catalogue of the Sclerogibbidae (Hymenoptera, Chrysoidea) of Eritrea

A b s t r a c t : The family Sclerogibbidae is represented by one species, *Sclerogibba magrettii* (KIEFFER, 1913) in Eritrea.

Introduction

The small family Sclerogibbidae, which is known from all zoogeographical regions, is represented by four genera and 19 species in the Afrotropical region. Until now, only one species, *Sclerogibba magrettii* (KIEFFER, 1913), has been recorded from Eritrea. Species of Sclerogibbidae are known as parasitoids of webspinners (Embioptera), but there are no host records from Eritrea.
