#### **Promising NADAs**

- Burundi has done Data Archiving Workshops
- Rwanda was introduced to DDI and received Technical support from Uganda
- All <u>SADC</u> Countries have been exposed to the Micro-data Management Toolkit
- Tunisia Using Micro-data Management Toolkit internally
- Morocco is about to start using the DDI

#### AfDB is to support introduction of Data Archiving in 12 Countries by end of 2010
