

Global Researcher Attitudes to Societal Impact: SDG3: GOOD HEALTH AND WELL-BEING


These findings are part of a **GLOBAL SURVEY** of more than **9,000** researchers. Over **2,600** researchers identified SDG3 as one of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) related to their research.



Researchers who identified **GOOD HEALTH AND WELL-BEING** as relevant to their research most often said that **QUALITY EDUCATION (26%)** and **INDUSTRY, INNOVATION, AND INFRASTRUCTURE (16%)** were related to their work as well.

THE IMPORTANCE OF SOCIETAL IMPACT TO RESEARCHERS


of researchers who identify SDG3 as related to their research describe **societal impact** as either **extremely or very important**.

strongly linked to demonstrable societal impact.






