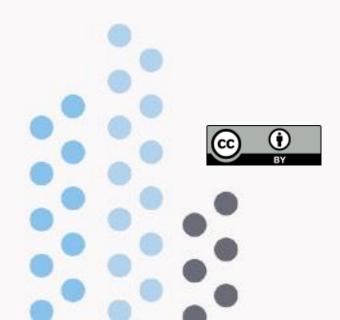

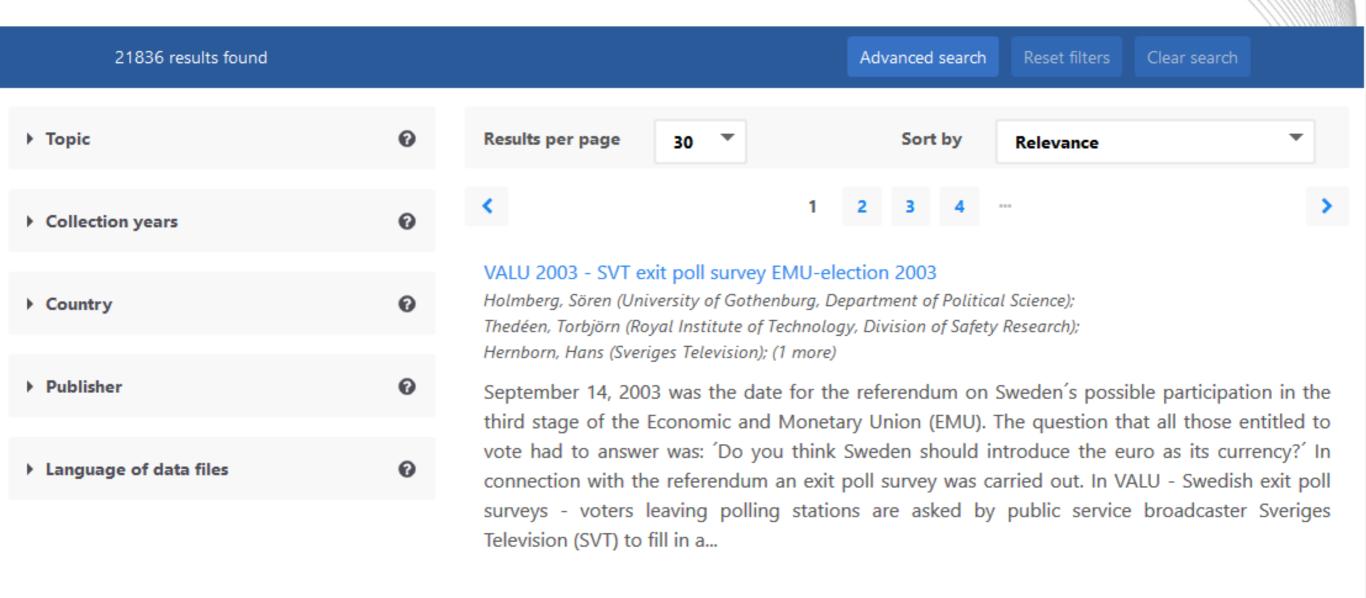

The Regional Western Sweden SOM Survey 2017

University of Gothenburg, SOM Institute

Western SOM has been conducted yearly since 1992, but was initially limited to residents of Gothenburg and its surrounding municipalities. In 1998, the survey was extended to include the entire Västra Götaland County plus the municipality of Kungsbacka. The purpose of the regional surveys is to enable SOM researchers to study attitudes and behaviour linked to local and regional issues. They emphasise public services and media, although many of the questions are identical with those used in N

Harvesting metadata from SPs

- Fully automated harvesting of metadata from Service Providers ensures that CDC content is up to date.
- Automatically updates its content every 24 hours.
- Any SP that has publicly accessible harvestable OAI-PMH endpoint that serves CMM compliant metadata in DDI 1.2/2.5 XML format can be part of CDC.
- Currently CDC holds circa 21000 records in English and 10000 records in other languages.

But it takes more than having a harvestable endpoint!

- CDC can be only as good as the metadata powering it.
- Better metadata => better search results, better facets
- As a rule, metadata should be corrected at the source.

Abstract

The survey charted a variety of values, attitudes and life situations of Finnish people. The respondents rated the importance of various domains in life (e.g. family, work, leisure time). The survey also investigated whether the respondents belonged to any voluntary organisations and participated in their activities. In addition, the respondents indicated whether they discussed politics with their friends and whether they were willing to participate financially in reducing the pollution of the environment. The respondents were asked to tell how often they see their friends and colleagues. In relation to prejudices against different groups with various characteristics, the respondents were asked which groups they would not like to have as neighbours (e.g. people of a different race, drug addicts, immigrants, homosexuals). Further questions covered general trust or mistrust of people. Views were also probed on ha Report a problem

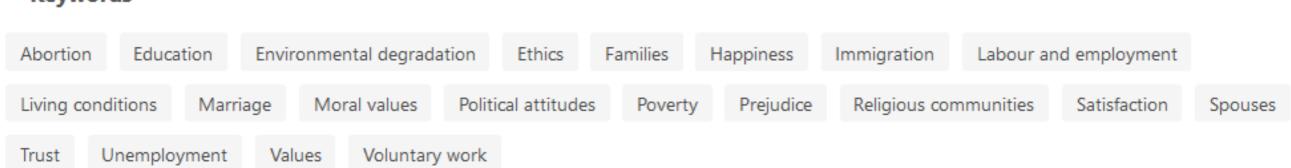

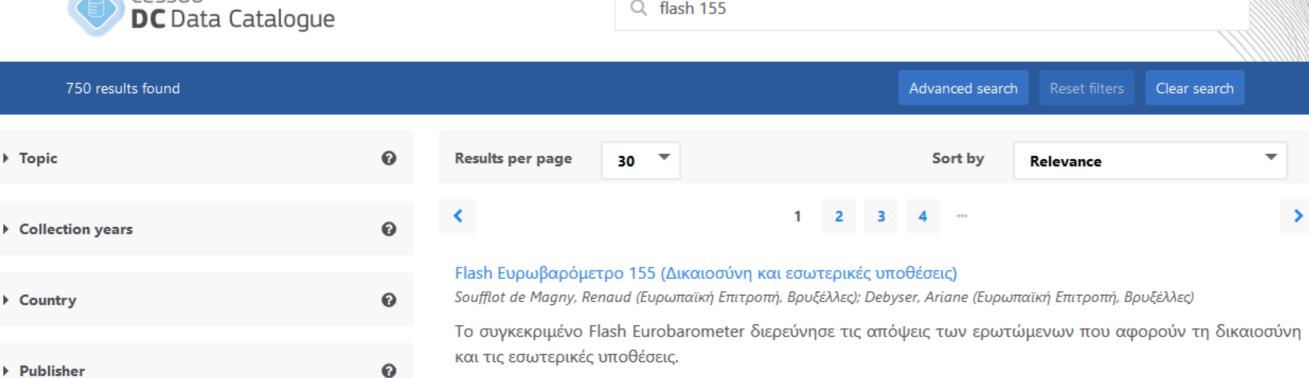
The language of the metadata file should be stated using <codeBook>@xml:lang, otherwise it defaults to English.

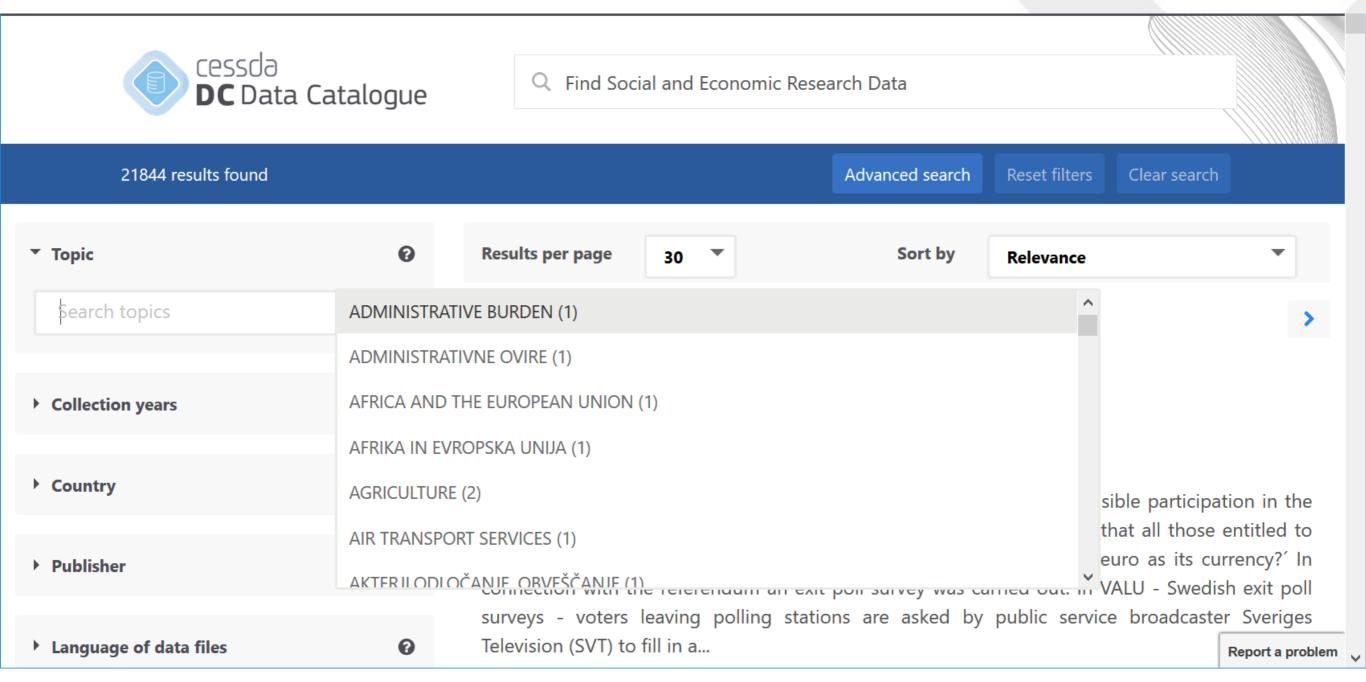

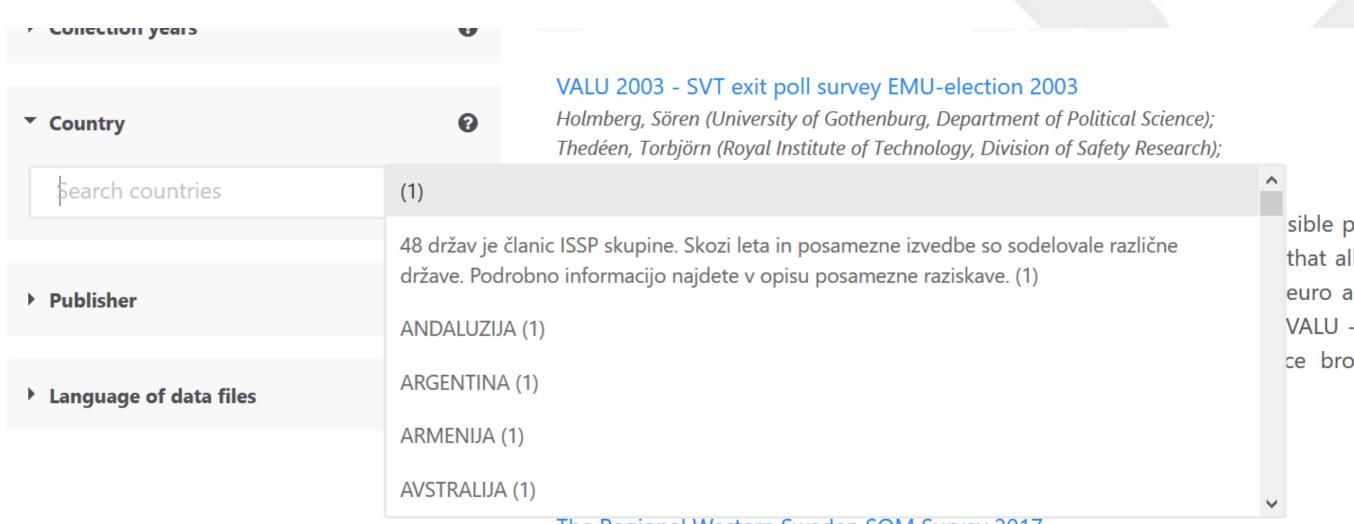

Use both the ISO country code in the attribute and country name

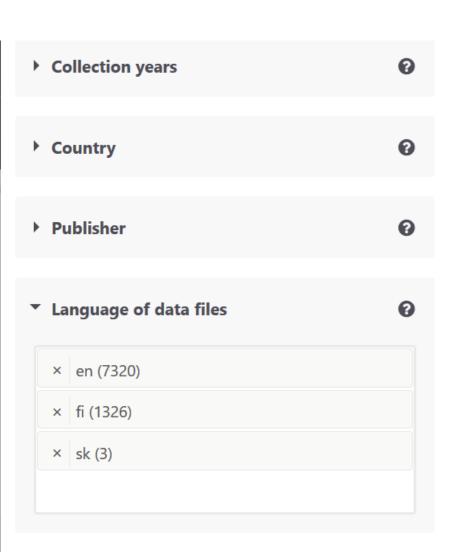

- Strongly recommended:
 - Year of publication
 - Data collection period (start and end)

- Ideally: 'YYYY-MM-DDThh:mm:ssZ'
 - can accept 'YYYY-MM-DD', 'YYYY-MM' or 'YYYY'



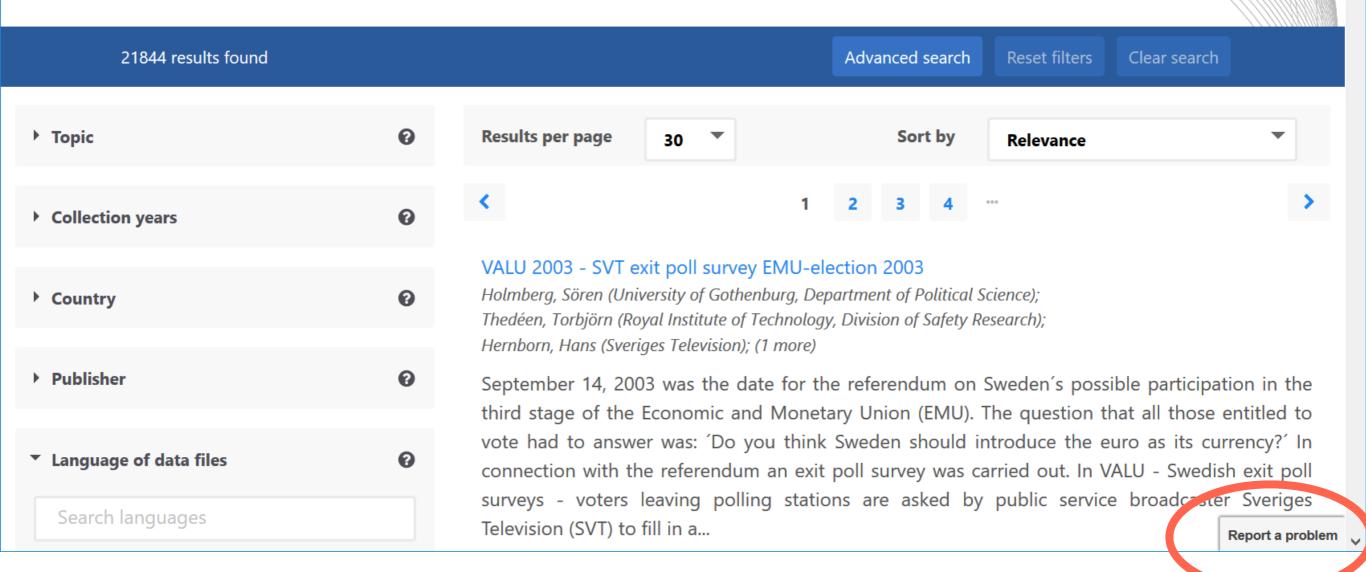
Check your metadata in CDC

- See the lists in other filters to chase incorrect country names, different spellings of organisation names, topic classification problems etc.

Summary: remember to...

- record the metadata language
- use controlled vocabularies whenever possible
- use attribute vocab name when using CESSDA topic classification
- be consistent
 - for example, don't use many variants of the name of your organization unless the name has really changed
- share experiences, provide feedback

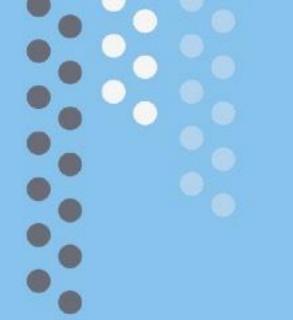
- Bug fixes
