### **Definition of discovery**



With the term discovery we mean **the capacity to explore**, **find**, **access**, **and reuse material** such as literature, data, projects, profiles etc. **that you would need for your own research work** (such as finding relevant papers, which will help with your research, or finding a person you are interested in collaborating with).
