

Ten Questions Concerning the NIME Publication Ecosystem

Archive & Journal

- Q1 What is the relationship between the proposed multimedia archive and proposed journal?
- Archive: flexible, evolving format, not peer reviewed, leverage existing **stable**, **free** media platforms (YouTube, Github, Zenodo etc...)
- Journal: stable, "traditional" format, peer-reviewed, NIME hosted, or with publisher
- Journal refers/links to archive content via citation

Archive example: ubuweb

- http://www.ubu.com/
- texts, visual scores, audio, video
- very stable since 1996
- runs with "no money" (via cooperation with partners?)
- find out how this works (Editor: Kenneth Goldsmith)

Q2 Do we need a NIME journal?

- Action taken: special issue of Computer Music Journal 26(3) (2002)
- **Q3** What **existing journals** are relevant? Are these sufficient?
- **Q4** Are **careers** negatively affected by lack of NIME journal?
- Q5 What do the potential authors/readers think? ('market' survey)

Q6 Publisher or Independent?

- **Publisher(+)** Infrastructure, Expertise, Stability, Prestige
- Publisher(-) cost to Author & Reader, uneven access, embargoes
- Indie(+) Open Access, Flexibility, Ownership
- Indie(-) Q7 Who has the time & I.t. commitment to do the work?
- Indie(-) Q8 Who pays? (hosting, labour, etc...)
- Indie(-) Q9 Is prestige affected by conflicts of interest, instability, amateurism?

Indie example: jmlr.org

- Journal of Machine Learning Research
- broke from Elsevier in 2001
- stable, good reputation, widely indexed, good impact
- simple, solid publication model
- open source **code archive** (Github)
- archived also at ACM Digital Library
