- **Environment:** Access to Research in the Environment ([OARE](#))
- **Applied sciences and other social science related disciplines:** Access to Research for Development and Innovation ([ARDI](#))

Research4Life: who is eligible?

- **Eligible:** Universities and colleges, research institutes, professional schools, agriculture extension centres, government offices, local non-governmental organizations (NGOs), hospitals and national libraries in eligible countries

- **Not eligible**
 - Local offices of international organizations are not eligible.
 - Individual membership is not allowed.
