



WHAT IS OER?



- Free learning materials that can be downloaded, edited & shared to better serve all students.
- Users have all rights to retain, reuse, revise, remix, and redistribute OER content.
- A broad range of high-quality resources.
- Give schools more local control of content and curriculum.
- Enable flexibility to reallocate resources to support teaching and learning.

What is OER?

- UNESCO's 2002 Forum on Open Courseware designates the Open Educational Resources (OER) as "teaching, learning and research materials in any medium, digital or otherwise, that reside in the public domain or have been released under an open license that permits no-cost access, use, adaptation and redistribution by others with no or limited restrictions. Open licensing is built within the existing framework of intellectual property rights as defined by relevant international conventions and respects the authorship of the work".


Five Freedoms of OER











Retain make, own and control copies Reuse use content in different ways Revise adapt, modify and alter content Remix combine original with other content Redistribute share copies of content



As stated in the OER definition, the openness in OER is enabled by open licensing, which gives users free and permanent permission to adapt and reuse.

According to the concept of the 'Five Freedoms' of OER, this means specifically:

- 1. Retain the right to make, own and control copies of the content (e.g., download, duplicate, store and manage)
- 2. Reuse the right to reuse the content verbatim or in its unaltered form (e.g., download, duplicate, store and manage)
- 3. Revise the right to adapt, adjust, modify or alter the content itself (e.g., translate the content into another language)
- 4. Remix the right to combine the original or revised content with other content to create something new (e.g., incorporate the content into a mashup)
- 5. Redistribute the right to make and share copies of the original content, revisions or remixes with others (e.g., give a copy of the content to a friend)

Envisaged Lifecycle of OER Made Possible through the Five Freedoms





2012 Paris OER Declaration

Recommends that States, within their capacities and authority:

- a. Foster awareness and use of OER.
- b. Facilitate enabling environments for use of Information & Communications Technologies (ICT).
- c. Reinforce the development of strategies and policies on OER.
- d. Promote the understanding and use of open licensing frameworks.
- e. Support capacity building for the sustainable development of quality learning materials.
- f. Foster strategic alliances for OER.
- g. Encourage the development and adaptation of OER in a variety of languages and cultural contexts.
- h. Encourage research on OER.
- i. Facilitate finding, retrieving and sharing of OER.
- j. Encourage the open licensing of educational materials produced with public funds.



National Resource Groups (NRGs) will train Key Resource Persons (KRPs) & State Resource Persons- Leadership (SRPL) of the States/Union Territories. One NRG includes 15 national level resource persons.



State Resource Group 33,000

One State Resource Group (SRG) includes 05 KRPs & 01 SRPL from SCERTs, DIETs, CTEs, IASEs. SRGs will train the school teachers and school principals (functionaries at district, block and cluster level).



Teachers, Principals, BRCs and CRCs

42,00,000

All the elementary school level Teachers, Principals, Block Resource Centre Coordinators (BRCs) & Cluster Resource Centre Coordinators (SRCs) will be trained by SRGs.











Conclusion

- OER in NEP2020
- To be created a National Educational Technology Forum (NETF), a platform to facilitate exchange of ideas on technology usage to improve learning.
- Given importance in creation of educational e-Contents for the regular and lifelong learners.
- UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020
- At least 60 percent of Self Learning Materials shall be developed by the in-house faculty of the Higher Educational Institution and the remaining percent of the materials can be sourced from available resources such as other Higher Educational Institutions, Open Educational Resources (OER), and SWAYAM, duly approved by the statutory authorities of the Higher Educational Institution. ... (p. 71)
- Quadrant-II is e-Content; which shall contain: self-instructional materials (digital self-learning materials), e-books, illustrations, case studies, presentations, etc., and also contain web resources such as further references, related links, open source contents on internet, videos, case studies, books including e-books, research papers and journals, anecdotal information, historical development of the subject, articles, etc. ... (p. 93)
- UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018
- Creation of ICT mediated Teaching Learning pedagogy and content and development of new and innovative courses and curricula: (d) E-Contents: Development of e-Content in 4 quadrants for a complete course/e-book; e-Content (developed in 4 quadrants) per module; Contribution to development of e-content module in complete course/paper/e-book (at least one quadrant); Editor of e-content for complete course/ paper/e-book. ... (p. 105)
