## Initiative for Open Abstracts Launches to Promote Discovery of Research


A new cross-publisher initiative calls for unrestricted availability of abstracts to boost the discovery of research

The **Initiative for Open Abstracts (I4OA)** calls on scholarly publishers to open their abstracts, and specifically to deposit them with Crossref. Unrestricted availability of abstracts will boost the discovery of research.

**40 publishers have already agreed to support I4OA** and to make their abstracts openly available. The full list of publishers is available on the I4OA website

I4OA is also supported by a large number of **research** funders, libraries and library associations, infrastructure providers, and open science organizations.
