Preliminaries

- Narratives are connecting elements between textual and pictorial traditions of the Middle Ages
- The interdisciplinary joint venture ONAMA is based on the extensive corpora of the two long-term projects MHDBDB and REALonline

MHDBDB (Middle High German Conceptual Database)

- Founded in the 1970s and online since the mid–1990s
- An onomasiological dictionary of Middle High German, based on the Hallig/von Wartburg terminology system
- Over 650 digitized academic editions of Middle High German texts
- Around 40,000 dictionary articles

REALonline

- Image database of the Institute for Medieval and Early Modern Reality Studies (IMAREAL), since the 1970s
- Research of the depicted objects / motifs and their meaning in the image discourse
- Over 22,500 data sets on works of art and objects
- Predominantly 13th to 16th century
- Over 1.2 million semantic annotations

Project Goals

- Development of an Ontology of Narratives (OWL)
- Semantic Annotation of a Corpus of Manuscripts and Images, based on the Corpora of REALonline and MHDBDB (RDF)
- Interlinking ONAMA with Recourses via the Semantic Web
- Web Frontend and GitHub Publication of the Ontology


Our Definition of Narratives

- Narratives focus on actions and action sequences
- Essential is a change of state
- Narratives are independent of their media
- Narratives are mental Concepts and they can be articulated as specific Realisations i.e. in texts and images

Research Questions


- How can medieval narratives be modelled in an ontology?

- What is the context of these realizations?






