- ✓ English language
- ✓ Prestigious journals
- ✓ International thematics

Countries of the South

- ✓ Peripheral science
- ✓ Local languages
- ✓ Local journals (paper)
- ✓ National thematics

The visibility of science depends on the hegemony of anglosaxon editors, politics and technological advancement

Scientific communications in Morocco

✓ Access to scientific information

✓ Irregularity of journals publication

Lack of financial support for academic publisher (offices, technological infrastructure, printing materials)

✓ Low scientific production

- ✓ Difficulties and pression to publish in prestigious journals
- ✓ Local issuess are neglected

Improve access, dissemination, and visibility of Moroccan scientific research








UNESCO

Knowledge for All

✓ Creation of open repositories to enhance local scientific production (social sciences, arabic, print journals);

✓ Inform researchers about databases that include many languages (DOAJ, DFAJ, Arabic citation index…);

✓ Encourage studies about scientific output of the south region (bibliometric indicators and science map);

✓ Science shops project (social responsibility of universities).

Local journals & local languages

- ✓ Creation of national databases of journals;
- ✓ National initiatives to index local journals in DOAJ;
- ✓ Coordination with institutions that initiate national journal portal (IMIST-Morocco, CERIST-Algeria, CNDST-Tunisia;
- ✓ Translation services to help Phd students.

Understanding Open Science

- ✓ Doctoral centers organize training sessions for researchers
- ✓ Creation of MOOCs «Scientific resources for researchers »
- ✓ Organisation of conferences about cognitive jusctice and decolonization of knowledge
- ✓ Highlight open access indicators in the international ranking (for decision makers)

Cooperation South/South

✓ Creation of open repositories, electronic journals and citation index to enhance visibility in North africa;

✓ Access to Research data.

The Key to Open Science Success?

✓ Development of National research system (research priorities);

✓ Strategies to develop university libraries;

✓ Enhance the quality of national journals (editorial board, plagiarism, etc.).
