- Reported in D5.8 Report on the Ambassador Programme

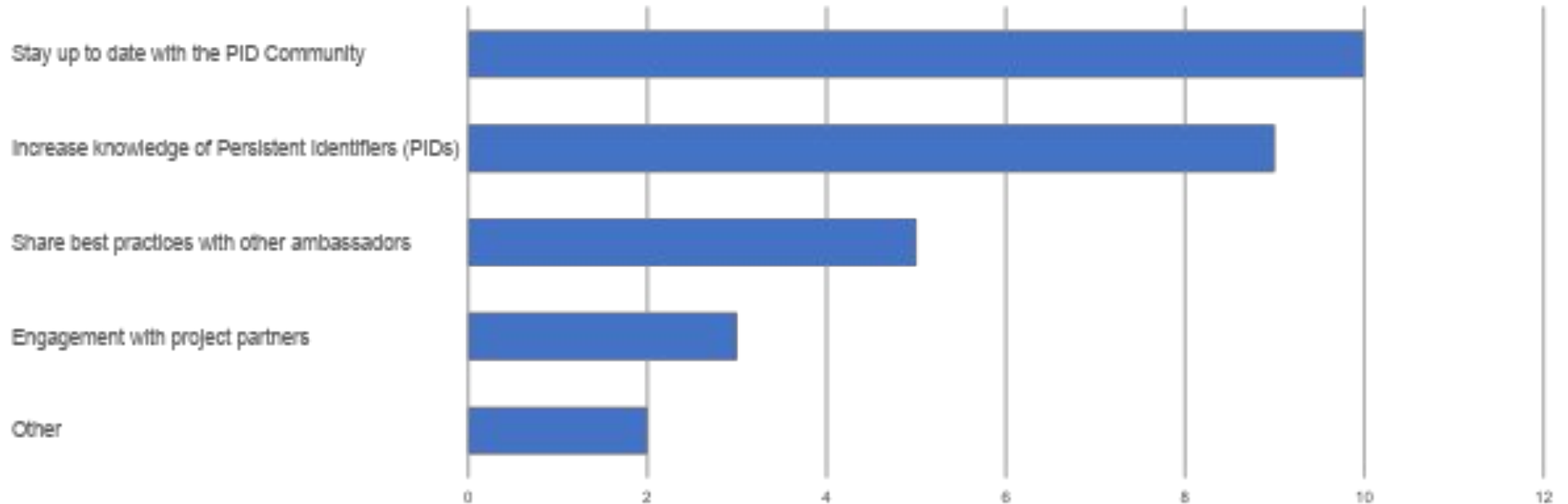

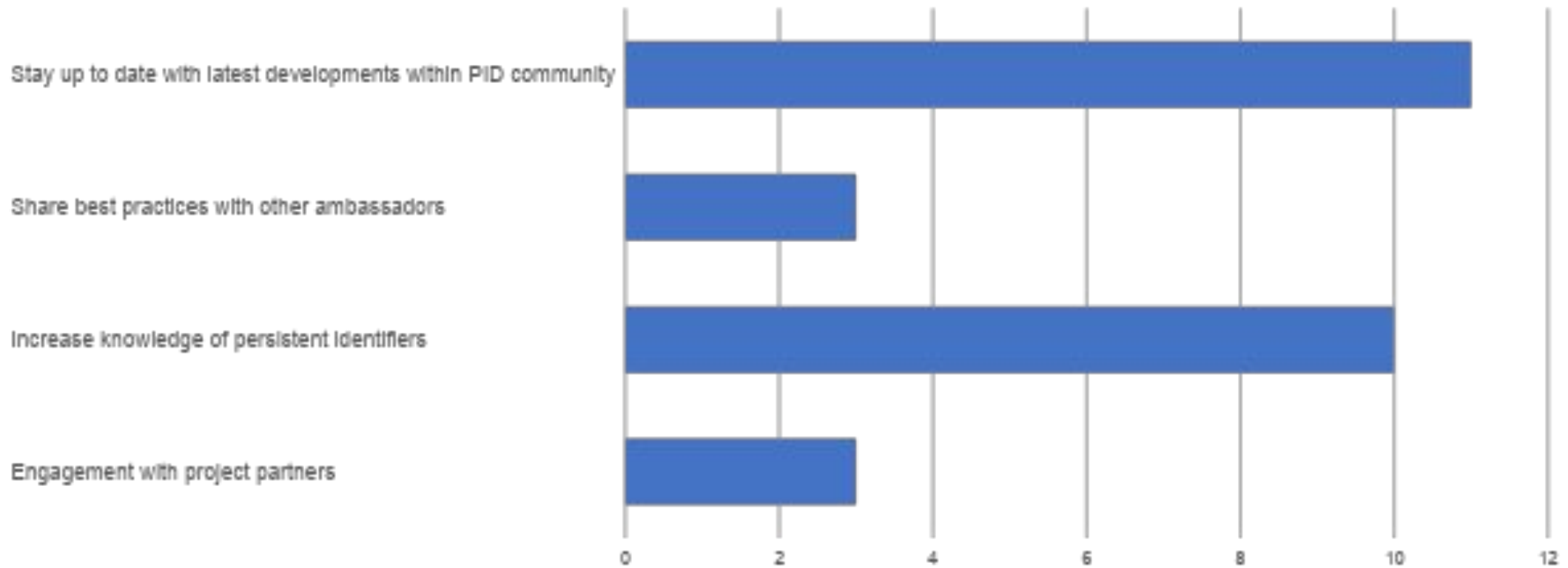
Why did you decide to become a FREYA ambassador?

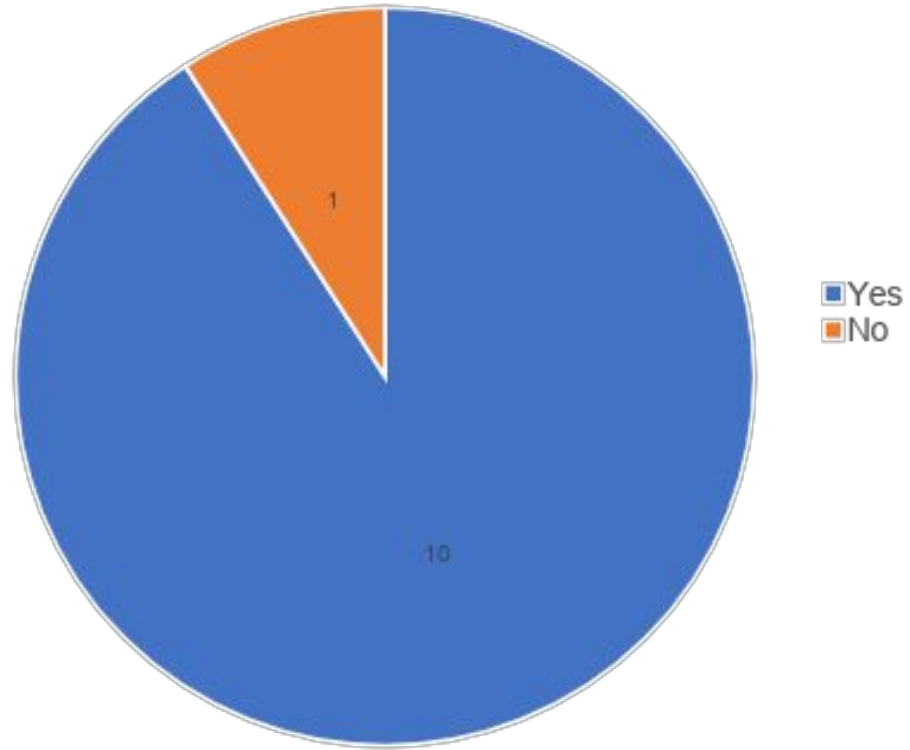
What are the benefits of being a FREYA ambassador?
