Discovery: through *searching* and *reading* it is a key activity in the research lifecycle.

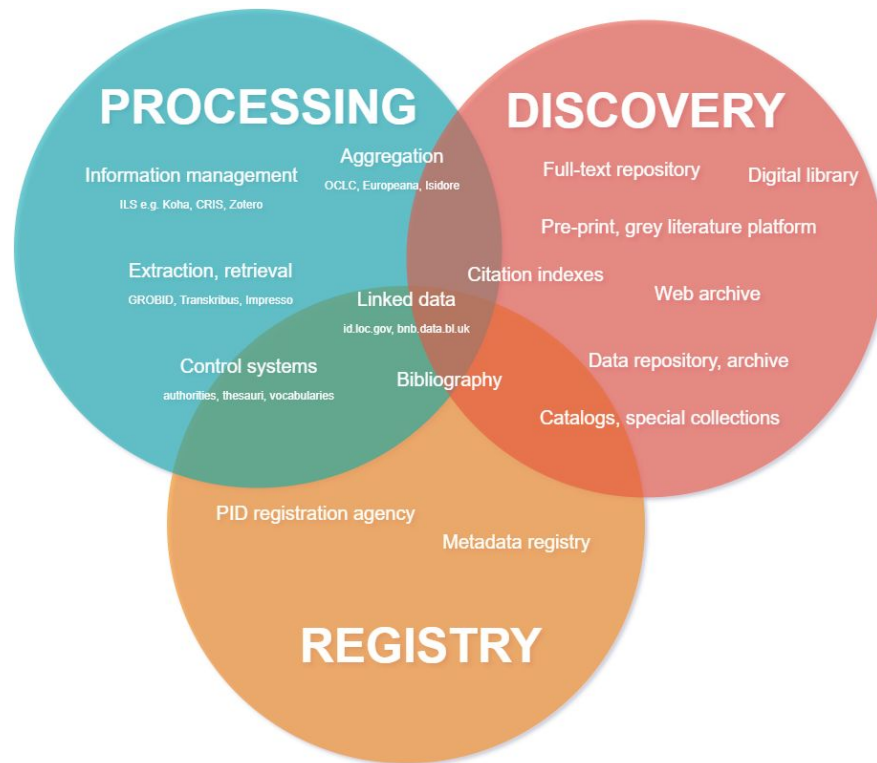

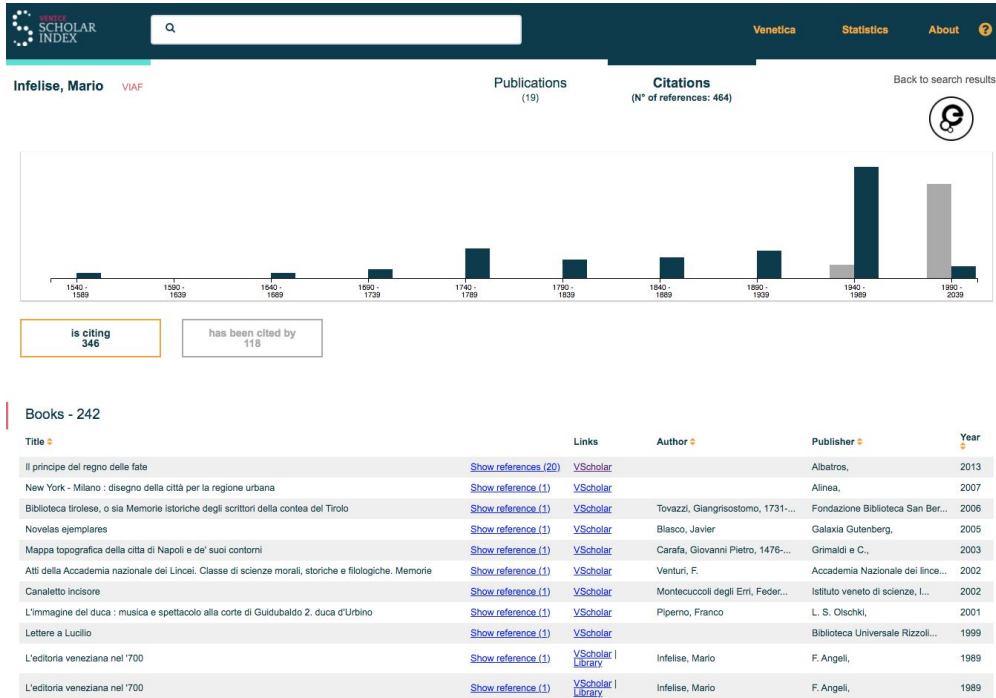

Prototype of an A&H citation index

Comprehensive coverage of literature on the history of Venice.

Discovery by “[surfing the citation web](#)”, including references to primary sources (archival documents).
