





The main objective of data dissemination

Develop the use of **statistical data** in **human and social sciences**



1- **Collect** and **store** official statistics



2- **Document** the Data with DDI
Production of descriptive notices



3- **Disseminate** the data among the scientific community



4- **Assist** and **advise** users (potential and current)





III. NEW PROCEDURE AND EVOLUTIONS TO COME

Statistical Confidentiality Committee

The Statistical Confidentiality Committee ensures compliance with the rules of **statistical confidentiality** and gives its opinion on requests to communicate individual data collected during statistical surveys or transmitted to the official statistical system for the purpose of compiling statistics.


Formalities with respect to the GDPR regarding data access are independent from the Committee ones, and need to be additionally dealt with.

The restricted access to *scientific use files* requires the collaboration of

- Adisp and Ined as distributors
- Statistical Confidentiality Committee for individual accreditation

Data request application

- A common tool for french data archives for social sciences :
 - CDSP : public use files
 - Adisp : public and scientific use files
 - INED : scientific use files



- Free
- Create a user profile
- Public use files → 2-3 days before receiving the data
- Scientific use file → Special process, especially for a first request since 2019

Scientific use files request (1/2)

since 2019 July 10th



Individual and manual verification in the application :

Direct dialog with the user to clarify any issues if necessary

- ✓ Profile + e-mail
- ✓ Project is coherent



Unique and nominative accreditation for any *Scientific use files* requests to come if the user is in an institution from the list

I the undersigned, **Firstname Name**, pledge to:

1 - not transmit in any case the information that will be made available to me, nor to state it in my relations with any third party

2 - make sure that studies and publications made from information that will be made available to me will respect:

- the general rules of statistical confidentiality
- secrecy rules that may be specific to certain sources (available in their documentation or from producers)
- in general, any procedure necessary to prevent the direct or indirect identification of individual statistical units

3 - communicate the results of the work based on this information and the publications that will be made to the Committee of Statistical Confidentiality ("Comité du Secret Statistique" in french), and as well to the Tax Statistics Office of the Directorate General of Public Finances (for work on tax-related data) and to mention in the publications the sources used

4 - to destroy:

- the production and research files after the end of the research work concerned
- the data sources transmitted by files (other than those made available via the CASD) before the end date of authorization and to inform the Committee of Statistical Confidentiality



User needs to sign a form for each distributor

Give access to the data

When we have the Statistical Confidentiality Committee agreement :

- We give access to requested data via the French data archives for social sciences request application
- The user receives a message in the application and can download documentation and data files



Horizon

We are working on a new data request application, in order to :

- Integrate Confidentiality agreement information
- Establish a connection to the “eduroam users base” to have automatic, not manual verification of email addresses
- Use Dataverse (DDI 2.5)
