21% of citations are irrelevant and 8% of quotations are inaccurate.¹


What can the referenced authors or readers do about misquotations, misrepresentations or abuse of ideas?

Contact the journal editor or other authors via email and inform them about the issue, this process can take ages before anything changes.

The current process for fixing inaccurate citations is manual, time consuming and inefficient.

Solution: MyCites

A patented concept for a browser extension that facilitates verification and annotation of citations.



- After installing MyCites, journal articles opened on webpages become annotatable.
- Every researcher with an ORCID id can use MyCites.
- Authors of the cited works are granted more visibility and authority over discussions.

MyCites affects the **accuracy** of citations and consequently, the **integrity** of scholarly publications via:

1. Creating awareness about the importance of citations.
2. Exposing inaccurate citations to deter malpractice.
3. Improving the efficiency of highlighting & reflecting on inaccurate citations.
