



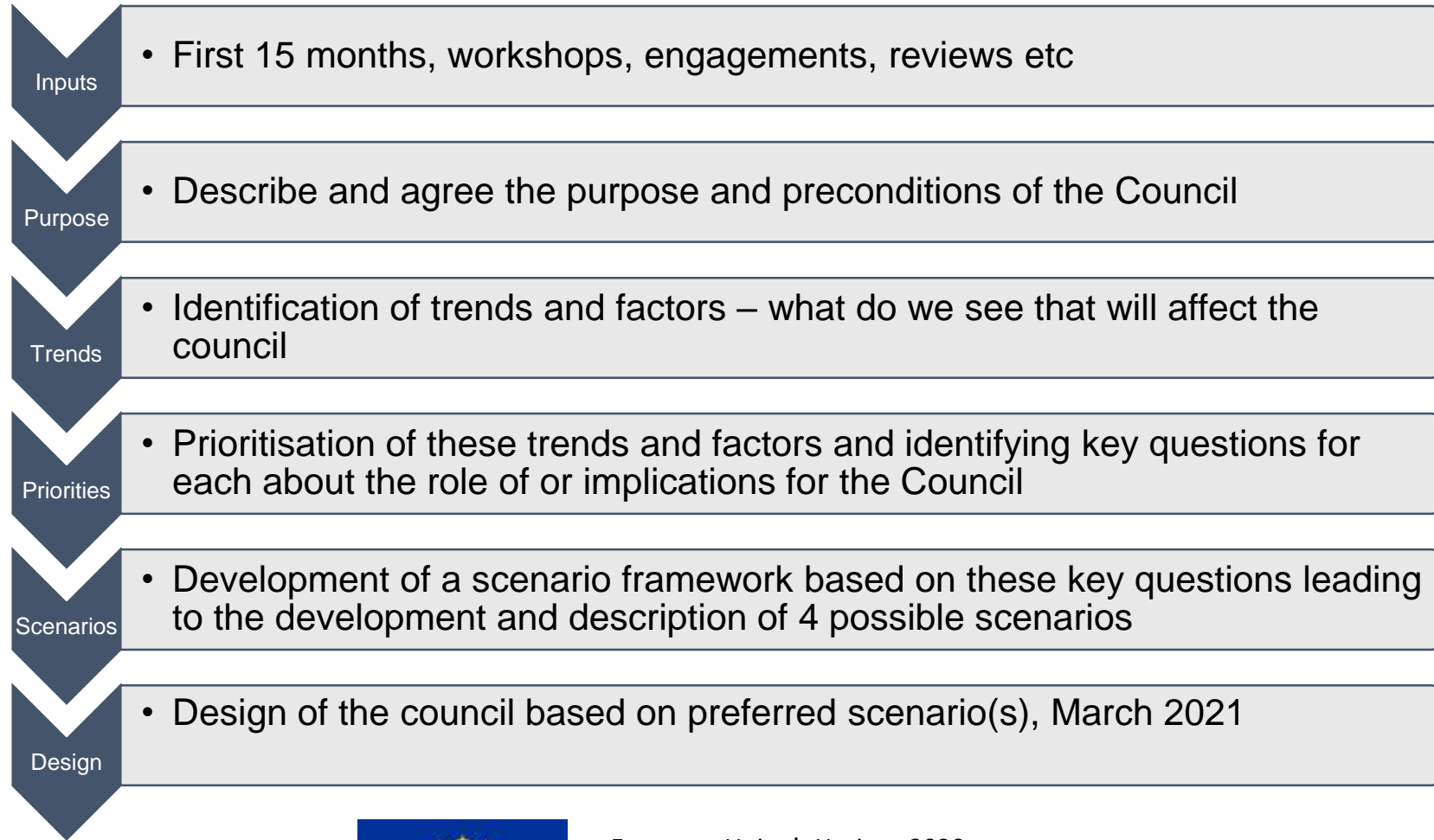

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Our process for Council design



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What are the potential services of the Nanorisk Governance Council?

Mapping

- 1 Providing stakeholders access to information on nanorisk issues and the landscape within which they operate.
- 1 Informing stakeholders on results from private and public research on nanorisk issues.
- 1 Providing a platform where stakeholders can share information on nanorisk issues.

Conducting analysis

- 2 3 4 5 Identifying emerging nanorisk issues, e.g. via foresight studies.
- 2 3 4 5 Identifying gaps in research, e.g. by engaging researchers in analysing gap analysis.
- 2 3 4 5 Conducting analysis upon request on nanorisk issues.
- 2 3 4 5 Monitoring progress on goals of the Nanorisk Governance Council, e.g. with a dashboard on selected indicators.

Stimulating dialogue

- 2 3 4 5 Engaging stakeholders in dialogue on nanorisk issues, e.g. with stakeholder meetings, conferences and public debates.

Organizing training

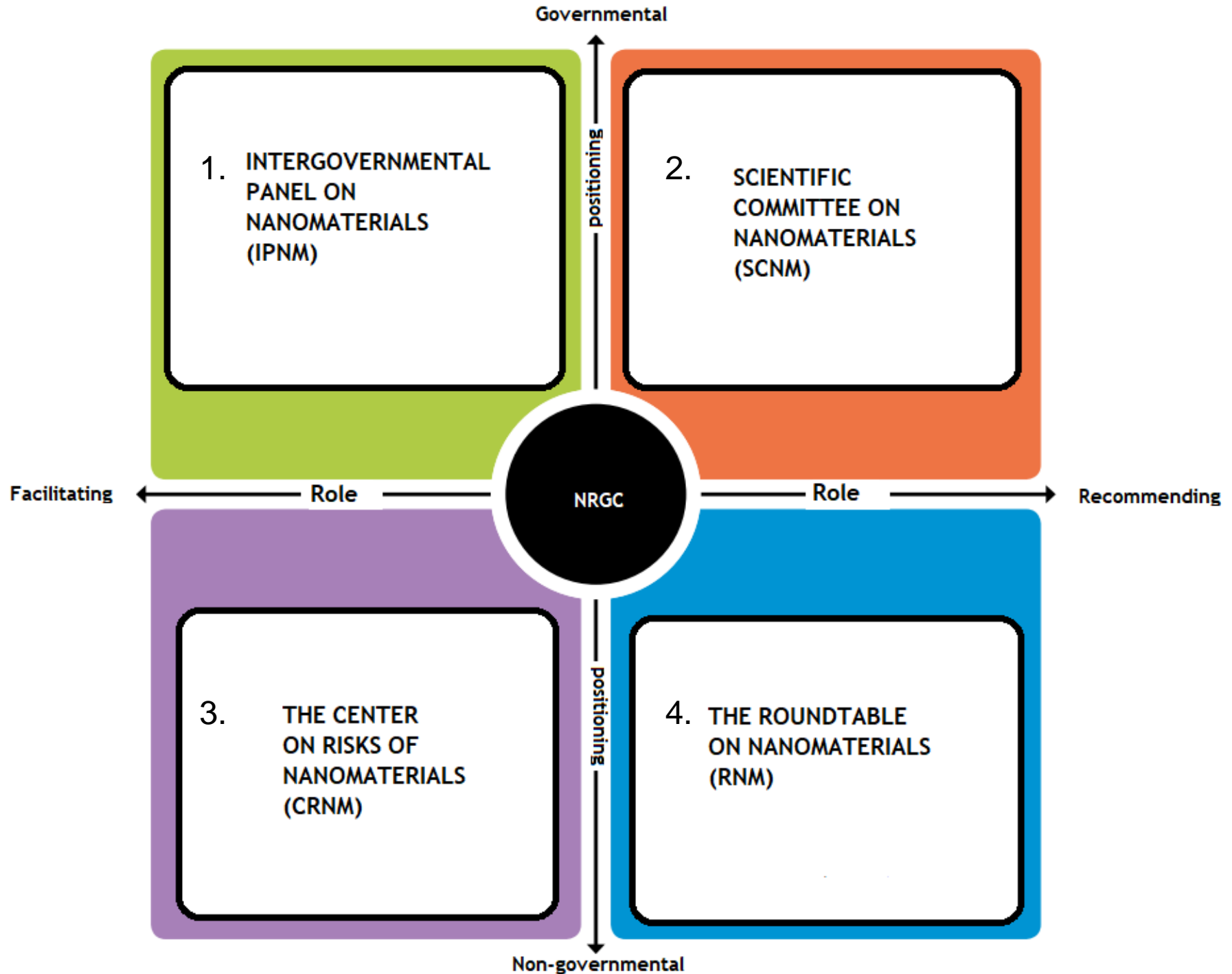
- 2 3 5 Organizing training opportunities for stakeholders, e.g. on safety-by-design or management of risks or data.
- 2 3 5 Linking stakeholders to relevant training opportunities.

Forming recommendations

- 2 3 4 5 Engaging stakeholders in forming joint positions on nanorisk issues, e.g. on research priorities.
- 2 3 4 5 Advocating stakeholder positions in other organisations, e.g. to decision makers on research programs.
- 2 3 4 5 Signaling topics for stakeholders to focus on, e.g. suggesting important research topics.
- 2 3 4 5 Providing policy makers and regulators with advice upon request on nanorisk issues to support decision making.

Forming plans

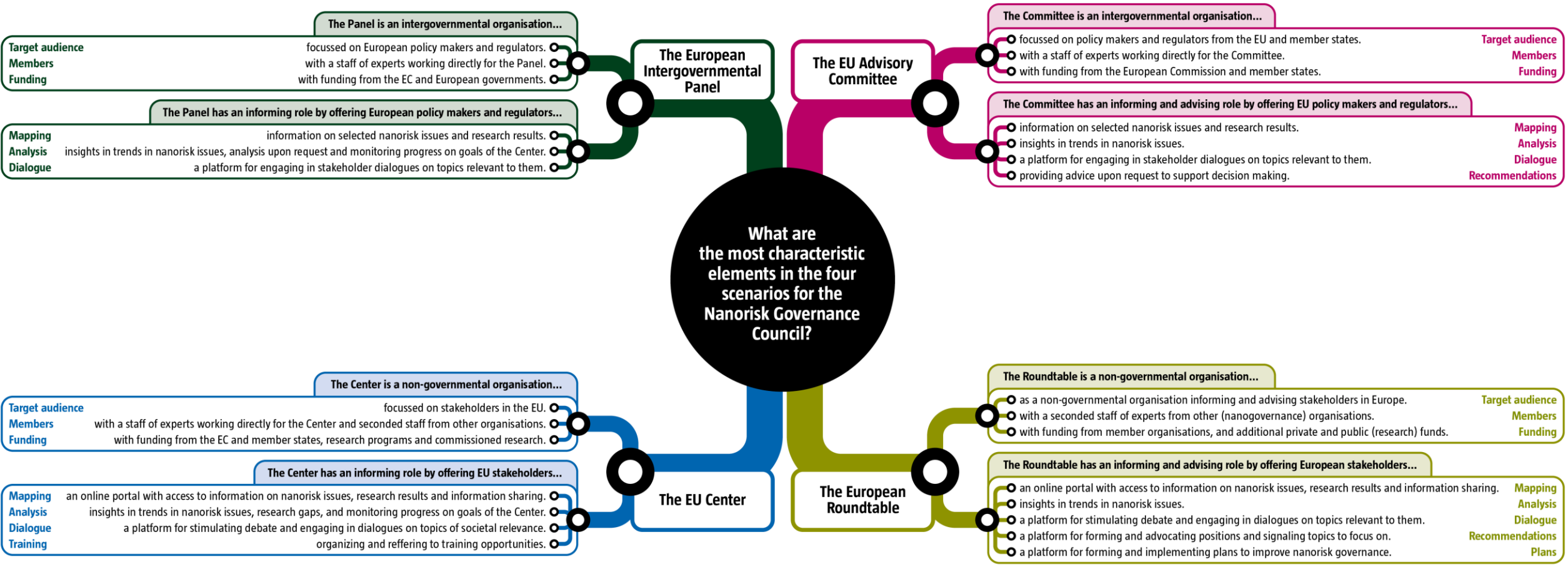
- 2 3 4 5 Engaging stakeholders in forming plans to improve safe and sustainable development, use and disposal of nanomaterials.
- 2 3 4 5 Helping stakeholder implement plans, e.g. by monitoring progress of implementation.
