

Notes for Data Sheet:

¹ **Family and Species name:** names according to the Catalogue of the Plants of Madagascar (<http://www.tropicos.org/Project/Madagascar>) unless marked with an (X), indicating that the name was found on the main webpage (<http://www.tropicos.org>) and not the specific Madagascar page.

² **Name as described:** species names as described by the authors (including misspellings). Common names (for which scientific name is not known) are also included in this column; “*” indicates that data are unavailable from the source.

³ **Distribution:** data from the Catalogue of the Plants of Madagascar or, where relevant, the main Tropicos page; “*” indicates that data are unavailable from the source.

⁴ **Lifeform/Habit:** data from the Catalogue of the Plants of Madagascar or, where relevant, the main Tropicos page; “*” indicates that data are unavailable from the source.

Leaf:	leaf	maturity of the leaf was not specified by author(s)
	leaf (immature)	immature leaf; groups similar terms together, includes: "new", "young", and "bud"
	leaf (mature)	mature leaf
	leaf (succulent)	specific description of a succulent plant
	leaf (tips)	author(s) specified the tips of the leaf were consumed
	frond (immature)	there were no mature fronds listed
Fruit:	fruit	ripeness of the fruit was not specified by authors; also includes "pulp"
	fruit (unripe)	unripe fruit
	fruit (ripe)	ripe fruit
	fruit (aril)	author(s) specified the aril of the fruit was consumed
	fruit (wings)	author(s) specified the wings of the fruit was consumed
Seed:	fruit (pulp with seed)	author(s) used a general "pulp/seed" category to suggest the seeds were consumed in addition to the pulp of the fruit
	fruit (seed)	seed was specified by author(s) in plant part description
Flower:	flower	maturity of the flower was not specified by author(s)
	bud	flower bud
	bulb	flower bulb
	petiole	flower petiole
	nectaries	flower nectaries
Other:	stem	stem
	wood	wood
	sap/exudate	descriptions of "sap" and "exudate" were combined to make sorting easier for the viewer
