
Open Research Europe

<u>Open Research Europe</u> (ORE) was established for the publication of research stemming from Horizon 2020 funding across all subject areas. The goal of the platform is to makes it easy for Horizon 2020 beneficiaries to comply with the open access terms of their funding and to offer researchers a publishing venue to share their results rapidly and facilitate open research discussion. All Horizon 2020 grantees are eligible to publish at no cost to them.

All articles are published using a fully transparent, author-driven model. Peer review is by invitation only and the names of the reviewers will be open. Each publication must have at least one author who has been, or still is, a recipient of a Horizon 2020 grant.

Publication in Open Research Europe is much more dynamic than in traditional journals and our articles are still "developing" after the authors' initial version is published. How to <u>submit a new version</u>?

Articles in ORE are thoroughly peer reviewed. The <u>peer review process</u> is led by the authors, which means that they are responsible for identifying appropriate experts from relevant fields. The editorial team are here to support the authors during the peer review process, and act as the intermediary between authors and reviewers.
