First update

This is the first update of the Belgian mental health (care) data repository of the Superior Health Council commissioned by the Policy Coordination Working group on Mental Health (Care). The update of this week includes a global overview of the already identified datasets.

General description of the data:

103 studies are currently included in the data repository for further analysis. The inclusion criteria for inclusion in future analyses are studies with large sample sizes (> 500) that investigate the impact of covid-19 on mental health (care) or studies with a lower sample size but good methodological design and with topics similar to already included studies. Currently, only studies that already have some data are included but we are also keeping track of upcoming studies. Most of the studies in the data repository are cross-sectional and pertain to the general population. 11 of those studies focus on children and adolescents, seven specifically on young adults and five on seniors. There also different specific target groups that have been studied. Five of those studies focus on health professionals, three on informal caretakers, five on individuals with pre-existing conditions and three studies on individuals in precarious situations.
