

EULA - End User License Agreement "KTH Chinese Whispers Corpus"

Version 1.0 – 21st of February 2020.

By signing this document the user, intended as who will make use of the corpus, agrees to the following terms. All data contained within the dataset have been collected and processed in accordance with the laws applicable in Sweden.

1. Commercial use

The user may not use the corpus for any commercial purpose. Commercial purposes include, but are not limited to:

- proving the efficiency of commercial systems,
- testing commercial systems,
- using screenshots of subjects from the corpus in advertisements,
- selling data from the corpus,
- broadcasting data from the corpus

2. Distribution

The user may not distribute or broadcast the corpus in any way. Small portions (i.e.: screenshots) may be distributed in publications as long as the publication complies with the terms stated in this EULA (article 4).

The user will forward all requests for copies of the corpus to the KTH Chinese Whispers corpus administrators at: diko@kth.se and jocke@speech.kth.se.

3. Access

The user may only use the corpus after this EULA has been signed and returned to the "KTH Division of Speech, Music and Hearing" - Stockholm – Sweden. The user must return the signed and dated EULA by email, in PDF format at: diko@kth.se and jocke@speech.kth.se.

Access is limited to the user signing this EULA form. The user may not grant anyone access to the corpus.

4. Publications

Publications include not only research papers, but also presentations for conferences or educational purposes. All documents and research papers that report on research that use the KTH Chinese Whispers corpus will acknowledge this as follows: "(Portions of) the research in this paper use the KTH Chinese Whispers corpus", and a citation to:
