The main research funder in the Netherlands.

Why do research funders take an interest in ORCID?



"Enter once, re-use often"

Why do funders implement ORCID?



To enable **researchers** to easily share information about their activities and affiliations with grant application systems.



To improve **data quality** for funders and the broader community and increase funders' capacity to monitor funded projects.

Benefits of ORCID for funders



In grant applications

Reduces the burden of manual data entry. This means fewer errors and more time for research.



In grant reviews

Allows for the recognition of review service which motivates researchers, and aids funder transparency.



In grant awards

Improves the accessibility of grant data, resulting in better attribution, easier administration, and more transparency.



In output reporting

Allows for increased efficiency and improved data quality, benefitting researchers and funders alike.

update: Crossref Grant-ID, status 23 March 2021 (2/2)

- Crossref has just over 16,400 grant records registered.
- Around 20 funding organisations have joined as members but have not yet started registering the grant metadata.
- We are finalising the work to have these records distributed openly via our REST API.

ORCID: Register / consent



aims: priority PIDs

- Research monitoring and analytics
- Structured input to national knowledge base
- A model for promoting PID practices

strategy: (national) community engagement

- Join ORCID-NL consortium, participate in consortium WG
- Participate in Netherlands PID advisory board (under development), tasked maintaining a current account of Dutch PID priorities, while remaining agile in the face of national and international developments

strategy: (international) engagement

- given the international nature of research and associated infrastructures, necessary to ensure national efforts are also well coordinated internationally
- Coordinate PID practices and strategies; collaborate within research funder organizations in Europe and/or internationally

aims: community engagement

[affordance] funder use-case offers a clear use case that covers the full life cycle of well-defined, temporarily and financially bounded research projects

- participate in shaping of national practices and priorities
- but internationally, what role can funders play to help shape the PID ecosystem?


