### History of Research Coding Club




#### **Physics Coding Club**

- → Tailored to be relevant to specific issues/needs in Department
- → Cycled location between 3 main Physics buildings
- → Weekly seminars/practicals during term time
- → Regular attendance between 7-15 people

#### Added drop-in Code Clinics

- → Individual help for research software related issues
- → From designing database schema to installing Python packages
- → Also switched to fortnightly sessions



#### What do we do?



  - Individual help with research software problems







