We recently set up a national node of OPERAS in Germany. On behalf of this forum, we would like to exchange ideas and experiences with you.

In a nutshell – OPERAS-GER is the first funded start of a national node. The aim of OPERAS-GER is to transfer the objectives and services of the project from the European level to the national level, and therefore to enhance awareness of OPERAS in Germany. Simultaneously, the German community aims to contribute at a European level in the form of services, knowledge and needs.

Currently, the main challenges we are facing in this process is a decentralised and fragmented landscape in Germany regarding the SSH. Obviously, the same is found at a European level. Thus, parallel structures are sometimes arising, which makes it more difficult for researchers to maintain an overview about open access possibilities. Furthermore, for publishers, libraries or research institutions it

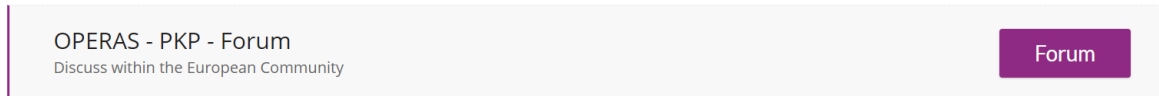


